## **Board of School Administrators 2021 Report**

Minn. Stat. 122A.091 Subd. 1; 2017 Minn. Laws 1st Spl. Session. Chap. 5 Art. 12 Sec. 13

**Topic:** Collect and report summary data on teacher and administrator preparation and performance outcomes.

## **Preliminary Findings:**

- Minnesota's preparation programs recommended 492 individuals for administrative licensure in the 2019-20 school year with 444 of them actually getting licensed for a 90% rate.
- It took the average candidate 21 months to complete their program.
- The average candidate took 31 credits to complete their program ranging from a high of 38 credits needed to complete the program to as low as 23 credits.
- The colleges have done an admirable job preparing American Indian candidates for administrative licensure. 2% of the candidates recommended for administrative licensure identified as American Indian with Minnesota's American Indian schoolaged population representing 1.2 % of the total population.
- Despite laudable efforts on the part of the universities, not surprisingly, candidates recommended for administrative licensure that identified as Asian, Black or Hispanic remained below that of the demographics of the children our schools serve with the most acute gap with the Hispanic numbers.
