The Office of Higher Education has reviewed its rules and the following rule became obsolete with the passage of Minnesota Statute 136A.823 on July 1, 2021, which repealed Subdivision 2:

-Minnesota Administrative Rule 4880.2500 - Categories of Chapter 141 Schools

The Office will seek to repeal this rule in the 2022 legislative session.
