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Interpretive Cautions and Notes

All demographic information is self-reported by examinees during the exam registration process. For the purpose of this report, the data of candidates who identified as “other” or “undeclared” is not disaggregated but is included in the total. For the “other” and “undeclared” data, refer to the MTLE Technical Reports posted on the [PELSB website](#).

Additionally, the preparation provider data is also self-reported. To qualify for a Tier 2 or a Tier 1 renewal, some individuals who never enrolled in a teacher preparation program identify the college where they completed their baccalaureate degree.

All pass rates are based on best attempt, defined as the percent of candidates who achieved a score equal to or higher than the passing score during the reporting period. If there are multiple attempts in the program year, the highest retake score is used in the calculation of the pass rate.

When there were fewer than 10 candidates who completed an exam at an individual preparation provider of a particular race or for a particular program area, only the pass rate is included and low n is indicated in the table below. When there were 10 or more candidates who took an exam at an individual provider of a particular race or by a particular program area, the pass rate and number of test takers is included.

Caution should be used when interpreting data for a small number of candidates.

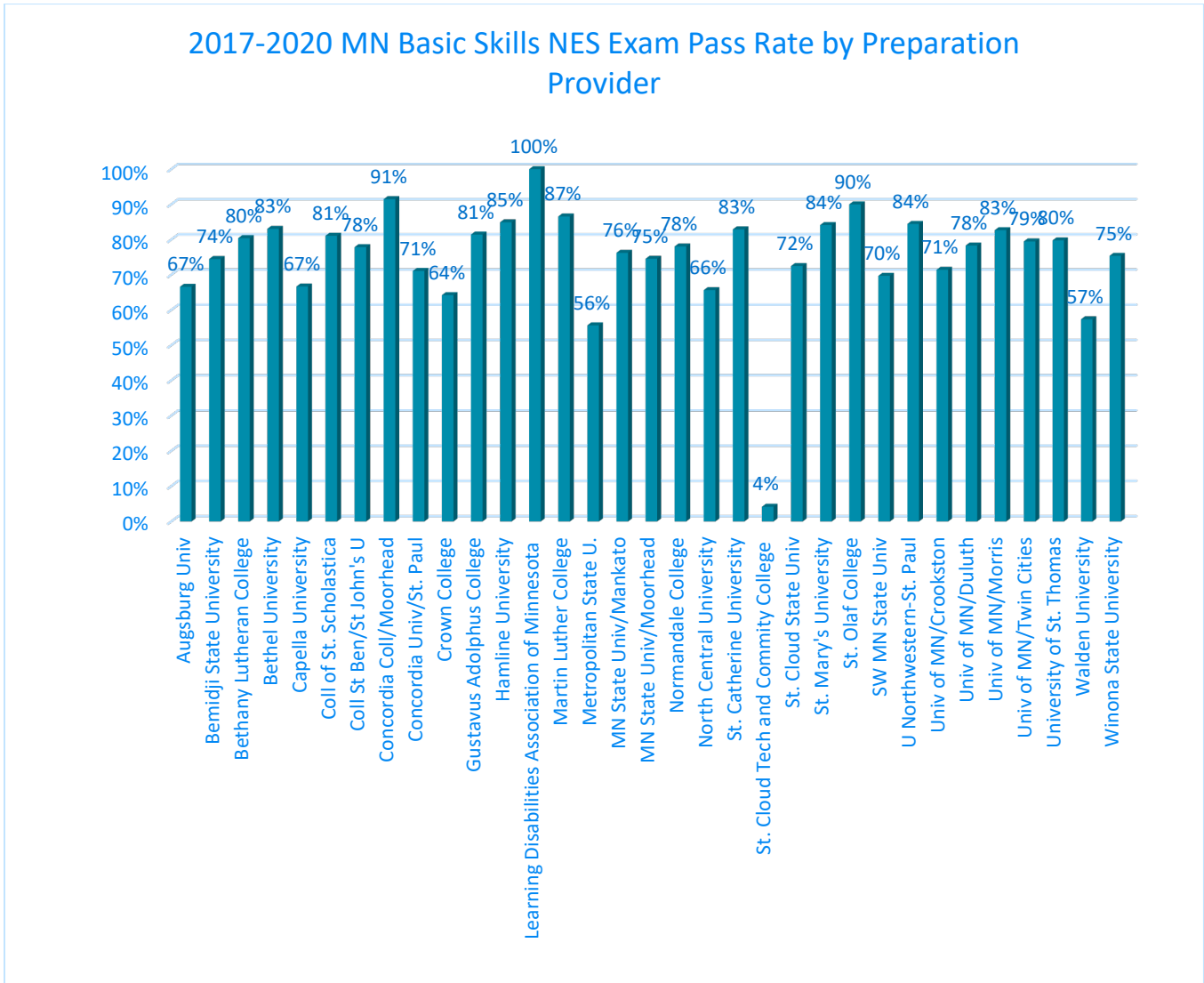
Basic Skills Exam Data

To qualify for a Tier 4 license, teachers may pass any one of the Board-adopted skills examination. The following table represents the data of one of the Board-adopted skills examinations, the MN NES Essential Academic Skills (EAS), from the last three years. To pass the test, a candidate must pass the entire battery, which includes an exam in math, reading, and writing. The significant decline in the number of candidates taking the MN NES EAS corresponds with moving the requirement from the standard teaching license to the Tier 4 license.

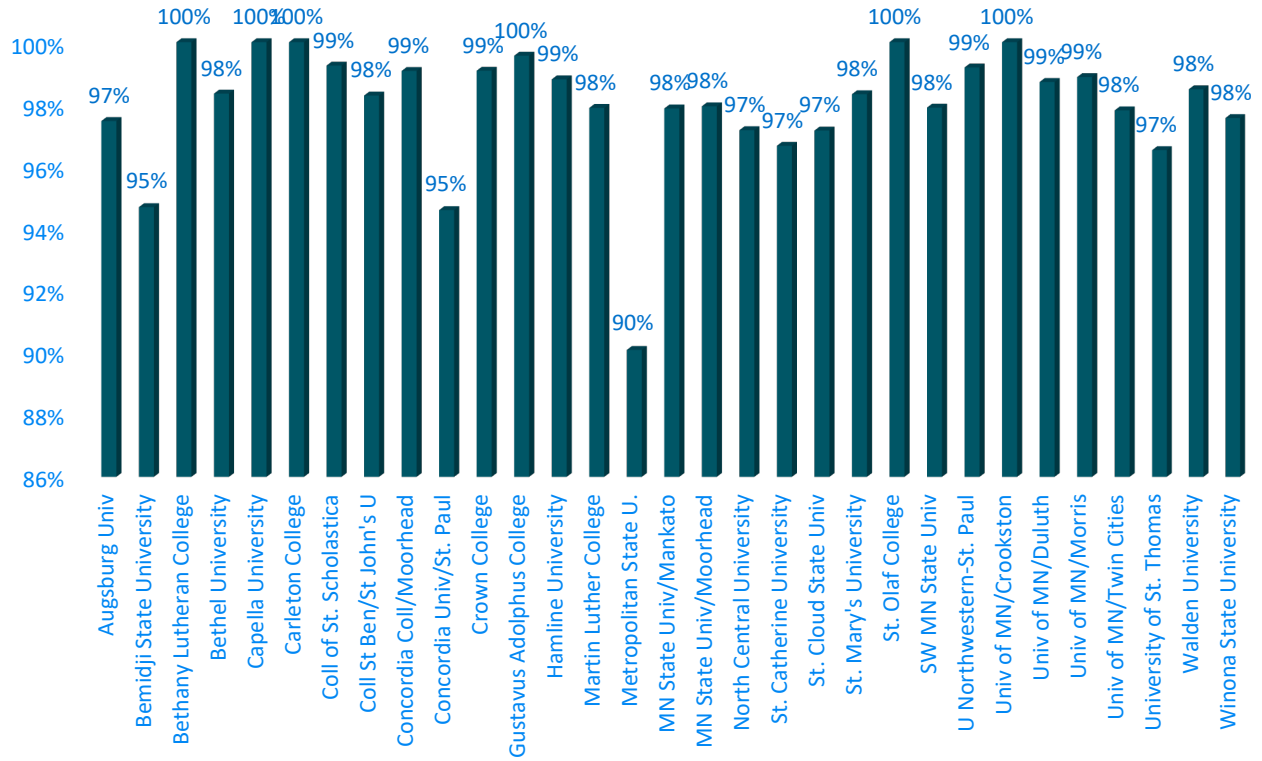
Pedagogy Exam Data

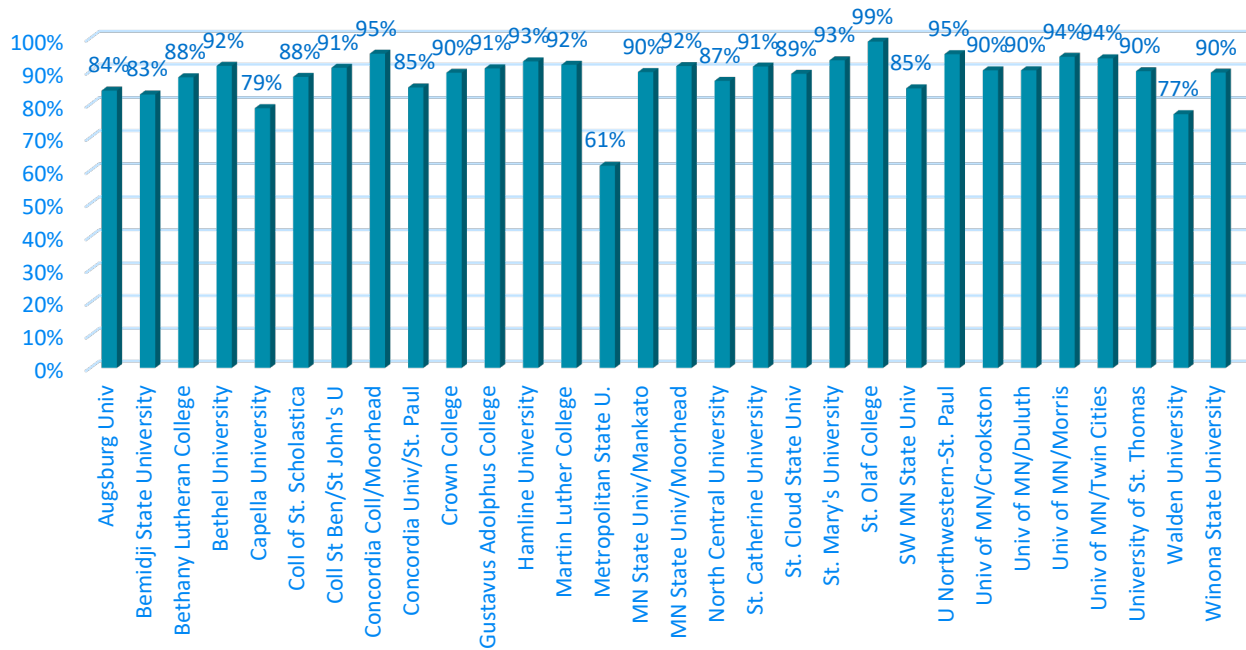
