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**Subject: Annual Submission of Rulemaking Docket and Official Rulemaking Record, as Required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 14.116(a)**

Dear Legislators:

In 2012 the Legislature amended Minnesota Statutes, section 14.116 to include the following requirement:

“(a) By January 15 each year, each agency must submit its rulemaking docket maintained under section [14.366](#), and the official rulemaking record required under section [14.365](#) for any rule adopted during the preceding calendar year, to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative policy and budget committees with jurisdiction over the subject matter of the proposed rule.”

Accordingly, the Minnesota Board of Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST Board) is submitting its current rulemaking docket, which can also be found at <https://dps.mn.gov/entity/post/Pages/rulemaking.aspx>.

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The POST Board initiated a rules overhaul as noted in the Request for Comments, published in the *State Register* on August 3, 2020. This is still in progress with an anticipated completion date in 2022.

Please note that you also have access to the key documents for any agency rulemaking at the Revisor's website on their "[Minnesota Rule Status](https://www.revisor.mn.gov/rules/status/)" webpage at <https://www.revisor.mn.gov/rules/status/>. You can search the state rulemaking documents by Revisor ID number, keyword, agency, dates, rule, or statutory authority. You can open documents related to an adopted rule, or the documents already made public for a rule that is still being adopted.
