Subject: Annual Report on Obsolete, Unnecessary, or Duplicative Rules, as Required by

Dear Governor Walz, Senators, Representatives, Director Hubinger and Revisor Inman:

Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5, directs the Minnesota Board of Executives for Long-Term Services and Supports to report to you each year whether any of its rules are “obsolete, unnecessary, [or] duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules.” Currently, the Board is nearing the completion of rule writing for the Health Service Executive and the Assisted Living Director as directed by the 2019 legislature. These are new rules, but we also addressed obsolete and/or unnecessary rules within that process. Currently, the Board has no rules to report which are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules.
