Dear Senators and Representatives,

Today we are providing you with the state's first Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Local Government Spending Report. The attached report shares background, allocation process, and local spending of the CRF by counties, towns, and cities in Minnesota. This report will also be available on the <u>COVID-19 Response Accountability Office</u> <u>website</u>.

On June 25, 2020, Governor Tim Walz and Lieutenant Governor Peggy Flanagan announced a plan, which was largely based on a previous legislative proposal, to distribute \$841 million of the state's federal CRF allotment to local governments to support coronavirus relief efforts. The Minnesota Department of Revenue received and approved certifications for 85 counties and 1,530 cities and townships. Twelve cities and 261 towns did not request distributions. Because they have more than 500,000 residents, Hennepin and Ramsey counties received distributions directly from the federal government.

This report shows spending by local governments through September 30. As of noon on October 23, 80% of local governments who received funds prior to September 15 had submitted an approved report to MMB. The COVID-19 Response Accountability Office continues ongoing outreach to cities, towns, and counties who have not submitted reports.

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The State of Minnesota distributed \$837,728,966, or 99.5%, of the original allotment to local governments between July 6 and October 16, 2020. Cities, towns, and counties have reported spending \$287,790,401, or 34% of the allocated funds as of September 30, 2020. Spending is defined as dollars a local government has actually spent on an eligible expense. The local government spending reports do not include amounts a city, town, or county has *planned* to spend. Local governments reporting \$0 in spending through September 30 may have COVID-19 related expenses, but may not have yet made an official decision on which expenses to assign to CRF funds.

Local government spending reports through October 31, 2020 are due to the COVID-19 Response Accountability Office by Tuesday, November 10.

During the Minnesota Department of Revenue certification process, local governments agreed to return unspent funds to the state of Minnesota to aid continuing coronavirus relief efforts. Unused funds roll up to the counties, who are required to return unspent funds to MMB by December 10, 2020. Returned funds will be used to offset general fund costs of COVID-19 response in accordance with 5th Special Session Law Chapter 3, Article 9, Section 12.

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Executive Summary

Status of distributed funds

- On June 25, 2020, Governor Tim Walz and Lieutenant Governor Peggy Flanagan announced a plan, which was largely based on a previous legislative proposal, to distribute \$841 million of the state's federal Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) allotment to local governments to support COVID-19 relief efforts. The Minnesota Department of Revenue (MDOR) received and approved local government certification forms for 85 counties and 1,530 cities and townships. Because they have more than 500,000 residents, Hennepin and Ramsey counties received their CRF distributions directly from the federal government. Twelve cities and 261 towns did not request distributions. Allotted funds were distributed on an ongoing basis starting within two weeks of the plan announcement.
- The State of Minnesota distributed \$837,728,966, or 99.5%, of the original allotment to local governments between July 6 and October 16, 2020. Cities, towns, and counties have reported spending \$287,790,401, or 34% of the allocated funds as of September 30, 2020. Spending is defined as dollars a local government has actually spent on an eligible expense. The local government spending reports do not include amounts a city, town, or county is planning to spend. Local governments reporting \$0 in spending through September 30 do not necessarily have zero COVID-related expenses, but rather may not have yet made an official decision on which expenses to assign to CRF funds.
- As of September 30, 2020, the three largest expenditure categories for local governments are: Payroll
 for Public Health and Safety Employees, Small Business Assistance, and Budgeted Personnel and Services
 Diverted to a Substantially Different Use. The total amount spent on these three categories is
 \$228,479,884 or 79% of the total spent through September 30.

Reporting requirements

- Local governments receiving CRF funds from the State of Minnesota must report expenditures to Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB) monthly. Reports must include the local government's identifying information as well as descriptions of expenses. Each expense must be assigned to one of the 18 categories provided by the U.S. Treasury for reporting purposes.
- The MMB COVID-19 Response Accountability Office has provided nine trainings for local governments on the reporting process and continues to provide ongoing training and education. Outreach and communication to local governments began in early July and will continue through the end of the year. Reports with missing information or errors are returned to the submitting local government for correction and resubmission.
- As of noon on October 23, 80% of the 1,170 local governments who received funds prior to September 15, 2020, have submitted an accepted report to MMB. MMB has also accepted 89 reports from the 445 local governments who received funds after September 15; data from those 89 reports is included in this report.

Background

The State of Minnesota distributed \$837,728,966, or 99.5%, of the original allotment to local governments between July 6 and October 16, 2020. The remaining 0.5%, or \$3,735,034, was not requested by local governments and will be re-purposed to aid the state's COVID-19 relief efforts.

According to federal guidance, CRF funds may only be used to cover costs that:

- 1. Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID–19)
- 2. Were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State or government

Any CRF distribution amount remaining unexpended on November 15, 2020, by an eligible city or town whose home county is an eligible county, must be sent to its home county by November 20, 2020. Cities and towns within Hennepin or Ramsey counties must grant unspent funds to a hospital in their respective county. Any amount remaining unexpended by an eligible county as of December 1, 2020, must be returned to MMB by December 10, 2020. Those funds will be used to offset general fund costs of the COVID-19 response as required by 5th Special Session Law Chapter 3, Article 9, Section 12.
