

About This Directory

For your convenience, the directory is organized into four major regions of the state: Twin Cities Metropolitan Area, Northern Minnesota, Central Minnesota and Southern Minnesota. Once you select the region you wish to visit, the markets are listed alphabetically by county.


Each listing tells the name of the farm or market, its location, hours open for business, products for sale and usually a phone number.

This directory is not an endorsement by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture or the Minnesota Grown Promotion Group of any of the farms, markets, orchards or roadside stands listed here. Each outlet sells Minnesota food products directly from farmer to customer. These outlets may also sell other products outside the scope of this directory, such as nursery stock, bedding plants, flowers, firewood, handicrafts, etc. A few outlets may also sell produce from outside the state. Always ask if the produce you are buying is "Minnesota Grown".

Remember, too, that Minnesota produce is also available at retail food stores. When shopping at your favorite grocery store, be sure to ask for "Minnesota Grown" produce.

Every attempt has been made to locate farmers' markets, roadside stands, orchards and pick-your-own farms. However, some may have been missed. If you know of any farm outlet that sells Minnesota food products directly to consumers, please contact:

Before you visit a farm or market, be sure to call ahead! _____

Market opening dates and crop availability are affected by the weather and are subject to change. A phone call will assure you that your trip won't be wasted.

Before you leave home:

- Call to verify that the farm or market is open.
- Ask whether the fruit or vegetable that you are seeking is available. Also ask about quality and quantity. Different stages of the season affect crop quantity and quality. For example, asparagus is better tasting early in the season, while winter squash is always best after a frost. Crop supply is often limited early in the season, while peak season crops are in large supply (prices may be lower in the peak season, too).
- Verify directions to the farm or market if it is your first visit.
- If you plan on bringing children or pets along, make sure they will be welcome. (Not all farms allow children or pets.)
- If you are picking your own produce, ask if containers are supplied.
- If you are planning on picking your own produce, you might want to wear comfortable clothes and bring along sunglasses, sunscreen or tanning lotion, a wide brimmed hat and, perhaps, a picnic lunch.
- If you are visiting a farmers' market, you might want to bring along a large bag with handles. Bringing small change or bills is helpful too.

How to Use Honey



In a cake or cookie recipe that calls for other sweetening, the general rule is to substitute $\frac{2}{3}$ cup honey for each cup of sugar in the recipe. Also reduce the amount of liquid by one quarter cup for each cup of honey used. When substituting honey in baked goods, add $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon baking soda to the recipe for every cup of honey used and bake it at a temperature about 25 degrees lower to prevent over-browning. Place pan or cookie sheet on middle or top oven rack for better results.

In many instances the honey you are using may have a high moisture content. If honey is not tightly covered when storing it may absorb moisture from the air. If this has happened it may be necessary to adjust your recipe slightly to compensate for the extra moisture in order to produce the desired consistency.

The Minnesota Honey Promotion Board would like to recommend that if you are not familiar with conversion, to begin with tested honey recipes first. For information and how to obtain more recipes write to Minnesota "Cooking with Honey", RT 1, Box 408R, Waverly, MN 55390. Your comments and questions are welcome.

Minnesota Grown along with Minnesota Honey Producers do not recommend giving honey to children 1 year of age or younger.

Canning Syrup

Honey helps canned fruit hold its shape, color and flavor. Mix the honey with water or juice. Heat until honey is dissolved. Skim if necessary.

Blueberry Cream Cheese Muffins

- 2 c. whole wheat flour
- 1 tsp. salt
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. baking soda
- 1 egg, beaten
- $\frac{3}{4}$ c. honey
- 2 T. oil
- $\frac{3}{4}$ c. milk
- 1 c. blueberries
- 1 3 oz. cream cheese

Sift flour and soda, set aside. Combine egg, honey, oil, and milk. Add flour and blueberries. Partially fill each muffin cup. Add small ball cream cheese; add batter to fill $\frac{2}{3}$ of cup. Bake at 350° F for 20 to 25 minutes.

Honey Spice Chicken Breasts

- 4 T butter
- $\frac{1}{2}$ c. honey
- 2 T Dijon-style mustard
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- $\frac{1}{4}$ c. fresh lime juice
- $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. savory
- $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. rosemary
- 3 whole chicken breasts, halved


In large skillet over medium heat, combine butter, honey, mustard, garlic, lime juice, savory and rosemary. Mix well. Remove from heat and pour over chicken. Let marinade for at least $\frac{1}{2}$ hour. Cook chicken 4 to 5 minutes per side over prepared barbecue grill. Baste with remaining marinade during the cooking process.

Wild Rice Waldorf Salad

- 2 c. wild rice, cooked & chilled
- 2 large Fireside, Cortland or Regent apples, peeled & diced
- 1 T lemon juice
- 1 T honey
- 2 stalks celery, sliced
- $\frac{1}{2}$ c. lowfat yogurt
- $\frac{1}{4}$ c. lowfat mayonnaise

Toss diced apples with lemon juice. Stir in celery and wild rice. Blend yogurt, honey and mayonnaise. Toss with salad ingredients. Chill. Makes 6 servings.

ANOKA COUNTY

Anoka County Farmer's Market - Located at Grace Lutheran Church parking lot, 13655 Round Lake Blvd, N.W. in Andover. Open 2 to 6 p.m. every Wed., from May 2 through October. Bedding plants, flowers, fresh vegetables, fruits and berries when in season. Also available are honey, maple syrup, poultry and rabbits. All items are locally grown or produced.

Anoka Rum River Tree Farm - Located ten miles north of Anoka on Round Lake Boulevard (Anoka County Road 9). Cut-your-own Christmas trees, November 23 to December 23. Daylight hours. Scotch pine, spruce, white pine, wreaths and garland. Call 612/493-5090.

Berry Ranch - Located north 35E, exit Hugo Exit (Highway 14), west 1/4 mile, north three miles. Open June, daily 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Call 612/779-0134, hotline 612/464-8592 (in season). Strawberries, many varieties.

Centerville Tree Farm - Located in city of Centerville (1770 Main Street), approximately ten miles north of Highway 694. Cut-your-own Christmas tree, Scotch pine, white pine and spruce. November 23 to December 22, daylight hours. Information: 612/493-5090.

Fireside Christmas Tree Farm - Over 5,000 Scotch, Norway and White Pine, Spruce and Balsam. Choose and cut from our E-Z drive-in fields or select freshly cut trees inside our barn. Santa's Workshop has unique hand crafted gifts and imported European decorations. Wreaths, garland, tree stands, tree bags. Free boughs. Free hayrides weekends until dusk. Open everyday 9 a.m. to 9 p.m., Thanksgiving to Christmas. Take Interstate 35 north to Forest Lake/County 2 Exit. Go left (west) on County 2/County 18 2-1/2 miles to the 4-way stop. CARVER COUNTY






