



Tips for visiting a farm or market



1 Call to make sure that the farm or market is open and to verify directions.

If you are visiting a farmers' market, bring along a large bag with handles, stroller, or wagon for hauling purchases. Carry change or small bills.



2 Ask if the product you are seeking is available. Also ask about quality and quantity. Different stages of the season affect crop quantity, quality and sometimes price.


If you plan to bring children or pets, make sure they are welcome. (Not all farms allow children or pets.)



3 Get there early for the best selection.

If you are picking your own produce, ask if containers are supplied. Wear comfortable clothes and bring along sunglasses, sunscreen, a wide brimmed hat, and perhaps a picnic.





Mediterranean Salsa

- | | |
|--|---|
| 2 cups diced (1/4-inch) peeled eggplant (about 1 medium) | 1 large tomato, cut into 1/2-inch dice |
| 1 cup diced (1/4-inch) zucchini (about 1 medium) | 2 tablespoons Heinz Apple Cider Vinegar |
| 1 cup diced (1/4-inch) green bell pepper | 1 tablespoon dried basil leaves |
| 1 cup diced (1/4-inch) red bell pepper | 1 teaspoon dried thyme leaves |
| 3 large cloves garlic, minced | 1 teaspoon salt |
| 2 tablespoons olive oil | 1/2 teaspoon coarsely ground black pepper |
| | 1/2 teaspoon sugar |

Sauté eggplant, zucchini, bell peppers and garlic in oil for 8 minutes. Add tomato and remaining ingredients. Cook 4 to 5 minutes until vegetables are tender-crisp. Cool.

Place in glass or plastic container and refrigerate, covered, up to 7 days. Serve as an accompaniment with chicken, pork, beef, lamb or fish, or as an appetizer with pita chips or toasted bread rounds. Makes about 3 cups.



Mixed Garden Pickles

- | | |
|--------------------------------------|--|
| 6 cups Heinz Distilled White Vinegar | 4 cups cauliflower flowerets |
| 4 cups granulated sugar | 4 cups carrot pieces (about 3/4-inch) |
| 1-1/2 cups water | 5 cups zucchini chunks (about 3/4-inch) |
| 3 tablespoons mixed pickling spice | 3 cups red or green bell pepper squares (about 3/4-inch) |
| 2 tablespoons pickling salt | |
| 5 cups broccoli flowerets | |

In an 8 to 10-quart saucepot, combine vinegar, sugar, water, pickling spice and salt. Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally. Boil for 4 minutes. Add vegetables; reduce heat and simmer until vegetables are hot, about 5 minutes. Immediately fill hot jars with mixture, leaving 1/2-inch headspace. Carefully run a nonmetallic utensil down inside of jars to remove trapped air bubbles. Wipe jar tops and threads clean. Place hot lids on jars and screw bands on firmly. Process in boiling water canner for 15 minutes. Makes about 4 quarts.



Southern Corn Relish

- | | |
|---|---|
| 2-1/2 cups Heinz Apple Cider or Distilled White Vinegar | 6 cups fresh corn kernels, cut from the cob |
| 1-3/4 cups granulated sugar | 2 cups minced green cabbage |
| 2 tablespoons pickling salt | 2 cups minced onion |
| 2 teaspoons dry mustard | 1 cup minced green bell pepper |
| 1-1/2 teaspoons turmeric | 1 cup minced red bell pepper |
| 1 teaspoon celery seed | 1 cup minced celery |
| | 1 jalapeno pepper, minced (optional) |

Combine vinegar, sugar, salt, mustard, turmeric and celery seed in large pot. Heat, stirring, until sugar and salt are dissolved. Add corn and remaining ingredients. Bring to a simmer over moderate heat, stirring occasionally. Simmer, uncovered, 30 to 40 minutes until vegetables are tender and mixture has slightly thickened. Using slotted spoon, immediately fill hot pint or half-pint jars with vegetables. Cover with cooking liquid, leaving a 1/2-inch headspace. Carefully run a nonmetallic utensil down inside of jars to remove trapped air bubbles. Wipe jar tops and threads clean. Place hot lids on jars and screw bands on firmly. Process pints or half-pints in boiling-water canner for 15 minutes. Makes about 5 pints or 10 half-pints.



Zesty Refrigerator Pickles

- | | |
|--|---------------------------------|
| 1-1/4 pounds 4-inch pickling cucumbers | 1 cup Heinz Apple Cider Vinegar |
| 1 cup sliced onions | 1 cup granulated sugar |
| 1 medium green pepper, cut into 1/2-inch pieces | 1 teaspoon mustard seed |
| 1 medium red bell pepper, cut into 1/2-inch pieces | 1 teaspoon celery seed |
| 1 tablespoon salt | 1/8 teaspoon turmeric |
| | 1/8 teaspoon crushed red pepper |

Thoroughly wash cucumbers; trim ends. Slice cucumbers 1/4-inch thick. In large bowl, combine cucumbers, onions, peppers and salt. Cover vegetables with ice cubes. Let stand 1 hour; drain thoroughly. In large saucepan, combine vinegar and remaining ingredients; heat just to boiling. Add vegetables; heat to boiling, stirring occasionally. Transfer to bowl or clean jars. Cover and refrigerate. Pickles are ready to eat in 24 hours. Pickles can be stored, covered, in refrigerator for 4 to 5 weeks. Makes 4 cups.

Note: 1-1/4 pounds cucumbers, washed, trimmed, sliced will yield about 4 cups.

Spicy Peach Chutney

|-------------------------------------|----------------------------|
| 2 pounds slightly underripe peaches | 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon |
| 1/2 cup Heinz Apple Cider Vinegar | 1/2 teaspoon allspice |
| 1 cup firmly packed brown sugar | 1/2 teaspoon salt |
| 1/2 cup raisins | 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves |
| 1 medium onion, chopped | 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg |
| 1 large clove garlic, minced | 1/8 teaspoon red pepper |



Peel peaches; pit and coarsely chop. Place in large saucepot with vinegar and remaining ingredients. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat to low and simmer, uncovered, 45 to 60 minutes until thickened, stirring every few minutes. Makes about 3-1/2 cups.



COOKING TIPS

For best results, use recipes developed for using honey.

When you substitute honey for granulated sugar in recipes:

-  Substitute honey for up to 1/2 of the sugar. With experimentation, honey can be substituted for all the sugar in some recipes.
-  Reduce the amount of liquid in the recipe by 1/4 cup for each cup of honey used in baked goods.
-  Add 1/4 to 3/4 teaspoon baking soda for each cup of honey used.
-  Reduce oven temperature by 25° F. to prevent over browning of baked goods..
-  Honey absorbs & retains moisture readily so baked goods will stay fresh longer.

BUYING TIPS

-  Select mildly flavored honeys, such as clover, for use in cooking where delicate flavors predominate.
-  Use strongly flavored honeys in spreads or recipes where a distinct honey flavor is desired.

STORAGE TIPS

Store honey at room temperature. When honey crystallizes, remove lid and place jar in warm water until crystals dissolve. Or, microcook 1 cup of honey in microwave-safe container at HIGH (100%) 2 to 3 minutes or until crystals dissolve; stir every 30 seconds. Do not boil or scorch.





FOLLOW THESE TIPS TO GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR MINNESOTA GROWN TREE.

- A freshly-cut tree will give better house life and needle retention.
- The stem heals over shortly after being cut, plugging water absorbing passages. To avoid this, cut at least 1/4" off the stem just before placing your tree in a stand.
- Keep water in the tree stand at all times to prevent the stem from healing over. A 7'-8' tree can absorb over one gallon of water each day. A tree stand that holds 1-2 gallons of water is best.
- Place your decorated tree away from fireplaces, heat registers or direct sunlight to keep it from drying out.




