- (9) the total number of participants terminated from the program under subdivision 5, paragraph (a), clauses (1) to (3);
- (10) the reimbursement policy for all payments listed under clause (4); and
- (11) the amount of all payments listed under clause (4) retained from participants who were terminated from the program.
- (b) The report must include all recommendations made by cities or counties regarding the future of the program and any necessary or suggested legislative changes.

## **REIMBURSEMENT POLICY -** report requirement (10)

All Participants Agree to the following policy:

- 1. I understand that if I opt out or I am removed from the program, Diversion Solutions will, to the best of their ability, pay any citations with the balance on my account after the participation fee has been satisfied. Any additional balance will be held by Diversion Solutions for 12 months from my removal date. If I should reapply within this 12 month period and I am accepted back into the program, the balance will be applied to my account to pay any additional fees and/or citations.
  If after 12 months I have not been accepted back into the program, any balance remaining will be forfeited to Diversion Solutions.
- 2. Over payments or payments in which a citation was paid via wage or savings garnishment is reimbursed within 6 weeks after notification that said citation was paid.
