Minnesota Department of Veterans Affairs Support Our Troops Grants/Expenditures for FY16

- \$225,786 Veterans Service Organizations Grants to the American Legion, VFW, Vietnam Veterans of America, Paralyzed Veterans of America, Military Order of the Purple Heart and the Disabled American Veterans. Funds are used to support the assistance provided to veterans and their families by Congressionally Chartered Veterans Service Organizations. These grants supplement grant funding provided pursuant to Minnesota Laws 2015, Chapter 77, Article 1, Section 37, Subdivision 2.
- **\$35,100 Becker County Veterans Court** Grant to support the Clay/Becker Veterans Treatment Court which is a specialized criminal court involving veterans charged with felony or gross misdemeanor non-violent criminal offense(s). Assists by diverting eligible veteran-defendants with substance dependency and/or mental illness.
- <u>\$6,300 DEED Career Fair</u> Funding for an interagency agreement with DEED to support their annual Veterans Career Fair in conjunction with Hire a Veteran Month in July.
- \$175,000 Housing Finance Agency Partially funded an interagency agreement with MHFA for the purpose of creating the position of Special Advisor for Ending Veteran Homelessness. The position assisted the State Director to Prevent and End Homelessness in addressing the issue of veteran homelessness in Minnesota.
- <u>\$74,016 NW Technical College</u> Expenditure to support the department's contract with NW Technical College, which provides staff and support services for LinkVet (1-888-LinkVet or https://linkvet.custhelp.com) veterans resource and referral system.
- \$50,000 Lutheran Social Services Funding to assist with staff salary and LSS intensive counseling for homeless Hearth Connection Veteran Clients to move individuals out of the GPD (Grants Per Diem) into independent living with counseling/support services.
- **\$12,740 Veteran Rapid Response** Funding for logistical support (facility, equipment rental, meals, etc.) for a special effort to provide rapid response services to veterans identified during the annual HUD Point-In-Time Count.
- **\$20,000 Wilder Homeless Survey** Funding to support the Wilder Foundation's annual Minnesota Homeless Survey as part of our obligations to the Minnesota Interagency Council on Homelessness. Ensures a special report on Homeless Veterans for agency use.
- **\$4,181 Statewide Systems Costs** Expenditure to support statewide systems costs for SWIFT, SEMA4 and other systems managed by MMB.
