WHEREAS, said assessment report discussed next steps that could be taken to improve and/or expand the NWRDC’s services and financial condition in the years ahead; and


WHEREAS, the NWRDC is satisfied with the its accomplishments spanning the previous five years along with its current programs and work objectives;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the “existence of the commission is in the public welfare and interest,” as required by the Regional Development Act.
