This letter provides the reporting for all expenditures of federal funds by replacement service providers, as required per 2021 MN Session Laws, Chapter 5, Article 4, Section 129. Plymouth Metrolink transit service requested CARES Act and CRRSAA Funds from the Metropolitan Council and subsequently received an allocation of **\$1,188,885** of CARES Act funds and **\$975,735** of CRRSAA funds. These funds were used on transit operating expenses including fuel, vehicle maintenance, and operation services. Please see attached documentation of these expenses.
