Your Excellency:

I am submitting for your consideration the report of the activities of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension for the calendar years 1933 and 1934.

The demands made on the bureau in 1933 and 1934 far exceeded the demands on it in previous years. The depression with its resulting unemployment has added to the field of criminals. There is more petty crime and more activity in major crimes, and the work of the bureau has increased accordingly, as is shown in the statistical report attached. The working facilities of the bureau have been stretched to the limit to meet the situation. The limited staff allowed the bureau has compelled our agents to put in long strenuous hours in the performance of their duties.

There is urgent need for additional employees. The present staff should be increased in order that the bureau may better serve the public. If the bureau is permitted to place agents in districts throughout the State as requested, so chosen that they can best serve the surrounding community, this would help materially in our efforts to combat the present crime wave.

Provision should also be made to have agents on duty in the bureau office all hours of the day and night to receive calls and reports from sheriffs and police officers, and, if necessary, go out on emergency calls. At present with our limited staff, this is impossible.

Under the present law the sheriffs of the state are requested to furnish the bureau with fingerprint records and photographs of all persons arrested by them. It is of the greatest importance that furnishing such data to the bureau be made compulsory on the part of the sheriffs. The prompt furnishing of these records and photographs by all sheriffs would increase the value of the work of the bureau and generally help law enforcement in the State.

All peace officers and sheriffs should be adequately equipped to cope with the criminal element who have the latest and most approved types of firearms and motor vehicles. The protectors of the persons and property of the citizens of the State are now at a tremendous disadvantage because of inadequate equipment.

The best methods of quick communication should be acquired. I would recommend a State owned and operated radio broadcasting station for police purposes, with radio receiving sets to be used in connection with such broadcasting station, the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to be charged with operating and maintaining the station. It should be the duty of the bureau to broadcast all police dispatches and reports submitted which have a reasonable relation to, or are connected with the apprehension of criminals, the prevention of crime, or the maintenance of peace and order in the State. Every sheriff and city obtaining a radio receiving set under such a provision should make reports to the superintendent of the bureau containing such information and at such times as the superintendent might require. The telephone and telegraph companies operating with the State should be required to give priority

to messages and calls directed to the State radio broadcasting stations, failure to do so to constitute a misdemeanor. It should be deemed a misdemeanor for any person to equip an automobile with a short-wave length radio receiving set, or use the same within the State unless the automobile is used or owned by a peace officer, or a permit is first obtained from the Superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension.

It was the realization of the need for better organization of the machine for the detection and apprehension of criminals to better cope with the modern developments of crime which led to organization of this bureau. That this might be accomplished, we have proceeded to carry out the provisions of the Act—Chapter 224, Session Laws 1927, of the State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. By furnishing the sheriff of every county assistance in the coordination of his work with other peace officers throughout the State, thus promoting greater efficiency in detecting and apprehending criminals and in enforcing the criminal laws of the State.
2. By providing methods for securing the cooperation of local peace officers with one another and closer cooperation between police officials and the bureau, by carrying out the present statute requiring the local police officials to furnish the bureau with records and reports of identification, apprehension and prosecution of criminals.
3. By broadcasting reports of crimes committed throughout the State which are transmitted to the bureau by sheriffs and police officers.
4. By establishing a Weekly Bulletin, which contains information on all crimes reported to the bureau by sheriffs and police departments throughout the State. This bulletin contains also a description of persons wanted on specific cases, a description of stolen property and the value of this property. The bulletin is mailed to sheriffs and police departments throughout the State, to police departments in the principal cities in the United States and to all State bureaus.
5. By mailing circulars on persons wanted on various charges and on persons missing, bearing photographs and fingerprints when available.
6. By exchanging photograph and fingerprint records with the National Bureau of Identification at Washington, D. C., with other State bureaus, with State and Federal prisons, and with other officials in the principal cities.
7. By receiving identification data on all persons arrested in the State on felony charges or as fugitives from justice or as suspicious characters.
8. By making immediate search of files upon receipt of any records and making prompt return of findings to the arresting officers.
9. By cooperating closely with the Department of Justice of the United States and with the National Bureau of Identification.
10. By keeping records and files on all cases worked on by agents of this department.
