Subject: Annual Report on Obsolete, Unnecessary, or Duplicative Rules as Required by *Minnesota Statutes*, section 14.05, subdivision 5

Dear Governor Walz, Director Weber, Legislators, and Mr. Inman:

Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5, directs state agencies to report to you by December 1 of each year whether any of its rules are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules.

The POST Board has reviewed its rules and has not found rules that are or have become obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative. The Board is in the process of updating all of its rules, as noted in the Request for Comments published in the *State Register* on August 3, 2020. As part of this proceeding, the board will identify obsolete rules to remove from its rules chapter. You can find information on the
