

Key Notes:

- This grant is administered by Second Harvest Heartland on behalf of the six Feeding America food banks who serve MN. Each food bank is responsible for distributing the food to the counties they serve.
- Second Harvest Heartland had to find other funding sources to source over \$107,000 worth of produce in Q3, due to F2F funds running out.
- The remainder of the milk funding was spent in Q3, requiring all six Minnesota food banks to now find other funding sources, subsidize the grant milk themselves, or pass on the cost of milk to agency partners.
- The price of both gallon and half gallon milk products that are funded by this grant have increased by 14% since the beginning of the fiscal year.
- For produce grant fund reimbursements, Second Harvest Heartland has claimed less than the maximum proportion of admin expenses from the grant funds. This allowed extra funding to go towards procuring more


