Red Lake Reservation

The Red Lake Reservation and scattered parcels of reservation land in the surrounding area are closed to non-band members of the Red Lake Band of Ojibwe except by authorization of the tribal council. Most of those lands are not posted, but they are marked in ownership plat books for Beltrami, Lake of the Woods, Koochiching, and Roseau counties. Rifle/shotgun restrictions

In the southern and western portion of the state, the only legal firearms for deer are shotguns using slugs, muzzleloaders, and handguns legal for big game. Muzzleloaders may be used throughout the state during the regular firearms seasons.

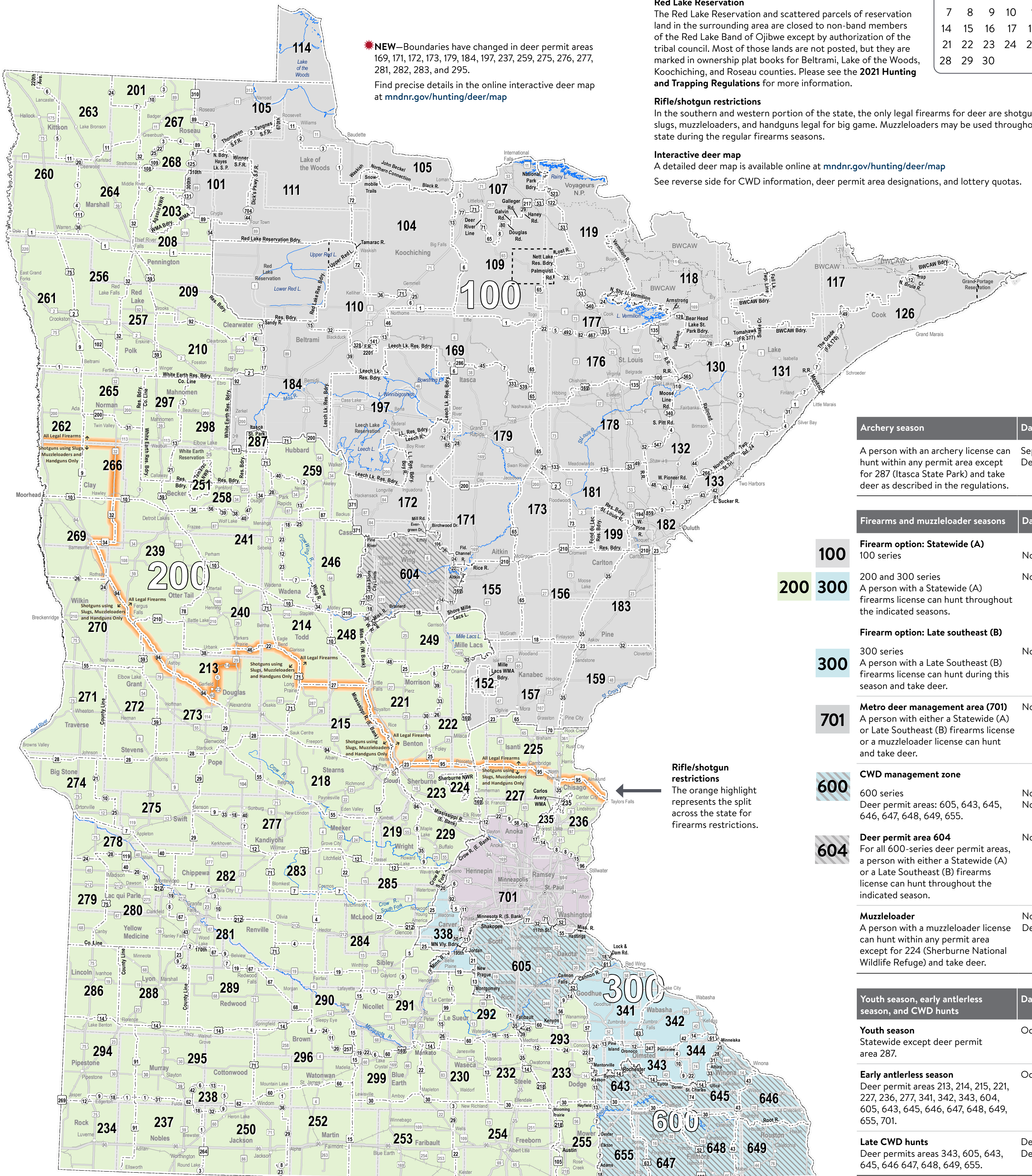
Interactive deer map

Archery season

A person with an archery license can hunt within any permit area except for 287 (Itasca State Park) and take deer as described in the regulations.

Firearms and muzzleloader seasons

100 Firearm option: **Statewide (A)**
100 series Nov. 6 - 21

200 300 200 and 300 series
A person with a Statewide (A) firearms license can hunt throughout the indicated seasons.

300 Firearm option: **Late southeast (B)**
300 series Nov. 20 - 28
A person with a Late Southeast (B) firearms license can hunt during this season and take deer.

701 Metro deer management area (701)
A person with either a Statewide (A) or Late Southeast (B) firearms license or a muzzleloader license can hunt and take deer. Nov. 6 - 28

600 CWD management zone
600 series Nov. 6 - 14 and Nov. 20 - 28
Deer permit areas: 605, 643, 645, 646, 647, 648, 649, 655.

604 Deer permit area 604
For all 600-series deer permit areas, a person with either a Statewide (A) or a Late Southeast (B) firearms license can hunt throughout the indicated season. Nov. 6 - 21

Muzzleloader
A person with a muzzleloader license can hunt within any permit area except for 224 (Sherburne National Wildlife Refuge) and take deer. Nov. 27 - Dec. 12

Youth season, early antlerless season, and CWD hunts

Youth season
Statewide except deer permit area 287. Oct. 21 - 24

Early antlerless season
Deer permit areas 213, 214, 215, 221, 227, 236, 277, 341, 342, 343, 604, 605, 643, 645, 646, 647, 648, 649, 655, 701. Oct. 21 - 24

Late CWD hunts
Deer permits areas 343, 605, 643, 645, 646, 647, 648, 649, 655. Dec. 17 - 19 and Dec. 31 - Jan. 2
