

Tree-ripened Minnesota apples come in a range of colors from green, to yellow, to red. Some varieties are sweet,



others slightly tart, others distinctively tangy and crisp.

You also may find that Minnesota strawberries, carrots or sweet corn are sweeter than you have tasted elsewhere. These are just a few examples of the unique taste treats in store for you if you seek out fresh, Minnesota grown produce.

Visiting a farmers' market, pick-your-own farm or apple orchard is also an enjoyable family outing. Often your visit can be timed with a special event, summer vacation or fall color outing.

Buying directly from the farmer will also assure you of produce fresh enough to freeze or can for use throughout the year. Often, you will be able to enjoy cost savings as well as great taste.

So, enjoy the taste of Minnesota. Whether you are seeking fruits or vegetables, wild rice or turkey, honey or cheese, our state offers you the best.

About This Directory

This directory lists outlets where consumers can buy fresh, Minnesota food products directly from Minnesota farmers. Each market or farm has indicated that they sell Minnesota food products such as fruits, vegetables, herbs, maple syrup, eggs, poultry, meat or cheese.

For your convenience, the directory is organized into four major regions of the state: northern, central, southern and the Twin Cities metropolitan area. Once you select the region you wish to visit, the markets are listed alphabetically by county.

Each listing tells the name of the farm or market, its location, hours open for business, products for sale and usually a phone number.

This directory is not an endorsement by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture of any of the farms, markets, orchards or roadside stands listed here. Each outlet sells Minnesota food products directly from farmer to consumer. These outlets may also sell other products outside the scope of this directory, such as nursery stock, bedding plants, flowers, firewood, handicraft, etc. A few outlets may also sell produce from outside the state. Always ask if the produce you are buying is "Minnesota grown".

Remember, too, that Minnesota produce is also available at retail food stores. When shopping at your favorite grocery store, be sure to ask for Minnesota grown produce.

Every attempt has been made to locate farmers' markets, roadside stands, orchards and pick-your-own farms. However, some may have been missed. If you know of any farm outlet that sells Minnesota food products directly to consumers, please contact the:

Before you visit a farm or market, be sure to call ahead!

Market opening dates and crop availability are affected by the weather and are subject to change. A phone call will assure you that your trip won't be wasted.

Before you leave home:

- Call to verify that the farm or market is open.
- Ask whether the fruit or vegetable that you are seeking is available. Also ask about quality and quantity. Different stages of the season affect crop quantity and quality. For example, asparagus is better tasting early in the season, while winter squash is always best after a frost. Crop supply is often limited early in the season, while peak season crops are in large supply. (Prices may be lower in the peak season, too.)
- Verify directions to the farm or market if it is your first visit.
- If you plan on bringing children or pets along, make sure they will be welcome. (Not all farms allow children or pets.)
- If you are picking your own produce, ask if containers are supplied.
- Do you need a map? Minnesota maps—as well as travel and special event information—are available from the Minnesota Travel Information Center at 296-5029 or 1-800-652-9747.
- If you are planning on picking your own produce, you might want to wear comfortable clothes and bring along sunglasses, sunscreen or tanning lotion, a wide brimmed hat and, perhaps, a picnic lunch.
- If you are visiting a farmers' market, you might want to bring along a large bag with handles. Bringing small change or bills is helpful too.

Apple Yogurt

3 cups apples, unpeeled 2 cups plain yogurt 1 tsp. vanilla ½ tsp. cinnamon 1 tsp. honey Cook apples in ½ cup water for 5-10 minutes until soft. Drain apples and lightly blend 2 cups of apples with 1 cup yogurt in blender with vanilla, cinnamon and honey. Stir all remaining apples and yogurt into blended mixture. Yields 1 quart.

Tomato Lake Bake


- 1-2 teaspoons lemon juice
- 1½ pounds walleye fillets
- 2 large fresh tomatoes, sliced
- ½ green pepper, chopped
- 2 tablespoons onion, chopped
- 1/4 cup breadcrumbs
- ½ teaspoon dried tarragon
- 1/2 teaspoon dried basil

1 tablespooth vegetable

chopped fresh parsley

Place fillets in a greased baking dish. Sprinkle with lemon juice, salt and pepper to taste. Layer tomato slices over fish and cover with green pepper and onion. Combine breadcrumbs, herbs and oil. Spread breadcrumb mixture over tomatoes. Bake in preheated 350° oven, uncovered, until walleye is firm and flakes easily. Serve hot with a garnish of fresh chopped parsley. Serves six.

Open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, from July 1 to November 1. All produce is organically grown. Call 218/384-3269 before coming to farm. Raspberries, picklers, dill, carrots, green and yellow beans, tomatoes, sweet corn, cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower, onions, potatoes, pumpkins, squash and beets.
- **6.** Carlton County Farmers' Market Located in Scanlon on Highway 45, just north of I-35 Scanlon exit. Open 2 p.m. until sold out on Tuesdays and 10 a.m. until sold out on Saturdays, from May 19 to October 30. Fresh fruits, vegetables, bedding plants, honey, maple syrup, crafts and baked goods.

No children under 12 allowed to pick strawberries.
- 15. Pinecrest Plantations Pick-your-own farm located 2 miles south of Blackberry at 1551 Cardinal Drive. Opens in July. Call 218/326-5965 (after 5 p.m.) before coming to farm. Strawberries and raspberries.





1 tsp. salt


1/2 cup rose wine

1 lb. peeled parsnips or turnips

1 tsp. salt

3 tbl. butter

1/4 tsp. white pepper

1/2 tsp. salt

Heavy cream

11/2 cups bread crumbs

2 hard boiled eggs

1/4 cup chopped parsley Peel parsnips or turnips and grate coarsely. Place in enough water to cover and add salt. Wait 40 minutes and then drain. Squeeze the excess water out with your hand.

Melt butter in saute pan and add parsnips or turnips. Saute for 10 minutes or until fork tender. Transfer to shallow baking dish and add enough heavy cream to cover.

Top with bread crumbs and bake at 375° for 30 minutes or until golden brown. Garnish with sliced hard boiled eggs and paprika.

Blended Winter Squash

1 hubbard or spaghetti squash 3 tbl. butter

2 tsp. brown sugar

1/2 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. ginger


1/8 tsp. ground cloves

Potato Garden Bake

2 lbs. washed and peeled potatoes

2 large ripe tomatoes

1 tbl. basil

1 cup grated mozzarella

1 cup cooked ham

chopped parsley

Slice potatoes into half-inch slices and boil until tender. Coat shallow baking dish with butter. Lay potatoes in a single layer. Slice tomatoes and put slices on top of potatoes. Distribute ham chunks over the tomatoes. Sprinkle basil and then grated mozzarella cheese. Bake at 350° for 20 to 30 minutes. Garnish with chopped parsley.

Serves 5 to 6.

Rainbow Beans

1 lb. green beans

1 lb. wax beans

3 tbl. butter

3 tbl. flour


2 cups vegetable stock

1 tbl. lemon juice

1 tbl. dill weed

1 tbl. chopped parsley

Cook beans until tender. In heavy saucepan melt butter and slowly add flour, stirring constantly. Cook on high heat for two minutes. Lower heat and gradually add stock. Stir over medium heat until mixture thickens. Add lemon juice and dill weed. Add beans and stir into mixture. Heat for four minutes and serve. Sprinkle parsley on top.
