Minnesota is blessed with scores of farmers who are growing asparagus, strawberries, carrots, peas, melons, peppers, potatoes, squash, sweet corn, tomatoes, apples and more.

Minnesota grown produce is worth seeking out.

Tomatoes are a great example. Shipped in tomatoes are picked green, shipped over long distances, and ripened with ethylene gas, a process that removes the homegrown tomato fragrance. Of course, we can't grow tomatoes during the winter, but when Minnesota tomatoes are in season they're worth looking for. One taste of a vine-ripened, flavorful tomato is all the proof you'll need.

Besides vine-ripened taste, Minnesota food products offer you some unique taste treats. Apples are just one example. For a delightful change of pace from Red Delicious apples, why not try some of the 21 varieties of apples developed especially for the Minnesota climate? Tree-ripened Minnesota apples come in a range of colors from green, to yellow, to red. Some varieties are sweet, others slightly tart, others distinctively tangy and crisp.

You also may find that Minnesota strawberries, carrots or sweet corn are sweeter than you have tasted elsewhere.



These are just a few examples of the unique taste treats in store for you if you seek out fresh, Minnesota grown produce.

Visiting a farmers' market, pick-your-own farm or apple orchard is also an enjoyable family outing. Often your visit can be timed with a special event, summer vacation or fall color outing.

Buying directly from the farmer will also assure you of produce fresh enough to freeze or can for use throughout the year. Often, you will be able to enjoy cost savings as well as great taste.


So, enjoy the taste of Minnesota. Whether you are seeking fruits or vegetables, wild rice or turkey, honey or cheese, our state offers you the best.

# Winter Squash Souffle

1 large winter squash ¼ cup honey ¼ cup molasses 3 T. flour 1 tsp. salt ¼ tsp. nutmeg ¼ tsp. ginger 3 eggs separated ½ cup chopped pecans Bake any winter squash until tender. Remove seeds and peel. Mix three cups of cooked squash with honey, molasses, flour, salt, nutmeg, ginger and egg yolk. Beat egg whites until stiff but not dry. Fold egg whites into squash mixture. Pour into buttered pan and sprinkle pecans on top. Bake at 350° for one hour.

### **About This Directory**

This directory lists outlets where consumers can buy fresh, Minnesota food products directly from Minnesota farmers. Each market or farm has indicated that they sell Minnesota food products such as fruits, vegetables, herbs, maple syrup, eggs, poultry, meat or cheese.

For your convenience, the directory is organized into four major regions of the state: northern, central, southern and the Twin Cities metropolitan area. Once you select the region you wish to visit, the markets are listed alphabetically by county.

Each listing tells the name of the farm or market, its location, hours open for business, products for sale and usually a phone number.

This directory is not an endorsement by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture or the Minnesota Grown Promotion Group of any of the farms, markets, orchards or roadside stands listed here. Each outlet sells Minnesota food products directly from farmer to consumer. These outlets may also sell other products outside the scope of this directory, such as nursery stock, bedding plants, flowers, firewood, handicraft, etc. A few outlets may also sell produce from outside the state. Always ask if the produce you are buying is "Minnesota grown".

Remember, too, that Minnesota produce is also available at retail food stores. When shopping at your favorite grocery store, be sure to ask for Minnesota grown produce.

Every attempt has been made to locate farmers' markets, roadside stands, orchards and pick-your-own farms. However, some may have been missed. If you know of any farm outlet that sells Minnesota food products directly to consumers, please contact the:

# Before you visit a farm or market, be sure to call ahead!

Market opening dates and crop availability are affected by the weather and are subject to change. A phone call will assure you that your trip won't be wasted.

Before you leave home:

- Call to verify that the farm or market is open.
- Ask whether the fruit or vegetable that you are seeking is available. Also ask about quality and quantity. Different stages of the season affect crop quantity and quality. For example, asparagus is better tasting early in the season, while winter squash is always best after a frost. Crop supply is often limited early in the season, while peak season crops are in large supply. (Prices may be lower in the peak season, too.)
- Verify directions to the farm or market if it is your first visit.
- If you plan on bringing children or pets along, make sure they will be welcome. (Not all farms allow children or pets.)
- If you are picking your own produce, ask if containers are supplied.
- Do you need a map? Minnesota maps—as well as travel and special event information—are available from the Minnesota Travel Information Center at 296-5029 or 1-800-652-9747.
- If you are planning on picking your own produce, you might want to wear comfortable clothes and bring along sunglasses, sunscreen or tanning lotion, a wide brimmed hat and, perhaps, a picnic lunch.
- If you are visiting a farmers' market, you might want to bring along a large bag with handles. Bringing small change or bills is helpful too.

### Hot Cheesy Potato Salad

#### 6 to 8 servings


#### 3 T. butter <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> cup sliced green onion <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup chopped green pepper 6 frankfurters, sliced <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-inch thick 4 cups cooked peeled cubed potatoes 1 cup dairy sour cream 5 tsp. flour <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp. salt 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp. prepared mustard Dash pepper 1 cup (4 oz.) shredded Cheddar Cheese

Serving size: 1/6 recipe. Approximate nutrient content per serving: 13 gms protein; 32 gms. fat; 20 gms. carbohydrates; 192 mgs. calcium; .22 mg riboflavin (B<sub>2</sub>) Melt butter in a large skillet; saute onion, green pepper and frankfurters about 5 minutes. Add potatoes. Cover and heat over low heat 15 to 20 minutes. Combine sour cream, flour, mustard, salt and pepper. Stir into skillet mixture. Heat 5 minutes longer. Do not boil. Sprinkle cheese over all. Heat, covered, until cheese is melted, about 3 minutes. Serve immediately.







12 8-inch corn tortillas 1 cup (15½ ounces) pinto beans or refried beans 1 pound oven roasted turkey breast, diced small 1 cup (4 ounces) grated cheddar cheese 2 cups chopped tomatoes 2-2½ cups chopped lettuce ¼-½ cup chopped onions 1 jar (8 ounces) taco sauce\* sour cream (optional) guacamole (optional)

Preheat oven to 375°F. Arrange tostados on 2 cookie sheets, overlapping if necessary. Bake 5 to 7 minutes or until crisp and lightly browned. Drain pinto beans and mash in small bowl. (Use refried beans as purchased.) Spread a heaping tablespoon on each tortilla. Divide turkey among tortillas and spread over bean mixture — about 2 heaping tablespoons for each. Sprinkle with cheese. Return to oven for 2 to 3 minutes or until cheese is melted. Serve with chopped tomatoes, lettuce, onions and taco sauce. If desired, top with sour cream and/or quacamole.
