About This Directory...

For your convenience, the directory is organized into four major regions of the state: Twin Cities Metropolitan Area, Northwestern Minnesota, Northeastern Minnesota and Southern Minnesota. Once you select the region you wish to visit, the markets are listed alphabetically by county.

Each listing tells the name of the farm or market, its location, hours open for business, products for sale and, usually, a phone number.

Buy Direct From Farmer to Consumer

This directory is not an endorsement by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture of any of the farms, markets, orchards or roadside stands listed here. Each outlet sells Minnesota products directly from farmer to consumer. These outlets may also sell other products outside the scope of this directory, such as nursery stock, bedding plants, flowers, firewood, handicrafts, etc. A few outlets may also sell products from outside the

state. Always ask if the products you are buying are "Minnesota Grown."

Ask for Minnesota Grown Products!

Remember, too, that Minnesota products are also available at retail food stores. When shopping at your favorite grocery store, be sure to ask for "Minnesota Grown" products.

Traveling Tips...

Before you leave home:

► Call to verify that the farm or market is open.

► Ask whether the product that you are seeking is available. Also ask about quality and quantity. Different stages of the season affect crop quantity and quality. For example, asparagus is better tasting early in the season, while winter squash is always best after a frost. Crop supply is often limited early in the season, while peak season crops are in large supply. (Prices may be lower in the peak season, too.)

► Verify directions to the farm or market if it is your first visit.

► If you plan on bringing children or pets along, make sure they will be welcome. (Not all farms allow children or pets.)

► If you are picking your own produce, ask if containers are supplied.

► If you are planning on

picking your own produce, you might want to wear comfortable clothes and bring along sunglasses, sunscreen or tanning lotion, a wide-brimmed hat and, perhaps, a picnic lunch.

► If you are visiting a farmers' market, you might want to bring along a large bag with handles. Bringing small change or bills is helpful too.

Fresh Fruit Salad with Poppy Seed Dressing

Salad:

**Fresh Strawberries
Fresh Minnesota Grown Apples
Fresh Minnesota Grown Grapes
Fresh Blueberries
Bananas
Peaches or nectarines**

Cut and toss equal parts of above, serve with poppy seed dressing.

Dressing:

**1/2 cup white-wine vinegar
1/4 cup sugar
1/3 cup water
2 teaspoons salt
1 teaspoon dry mustard
1 garlic clove, minced
1 tablespoon poppy seeds
1 tablespoon celery seeds
1 cup olive oil**

In a bowl mix together vinegar, sugar, water, salt, mustard, garlic, poppy seeds, celery seeds and pepper to taste, whisking until the sugar is dissolved, add the oil in a slow stream, whisking until the dressing is emulsified. Chill covered for 3 hours, shake before using.

Frugal-Style Pickled Beets

**2 or more cylindra beets
1/2 jar pickle juice, strained**

Scrape the beets to remove tan outer skin. Remove the tips and tops and cut beets into 1/4-inch or thinner slices (square or bias style). Steam slices in a covered sauce pan with 1/4-inch water in the bottom until fork-soft. Drain off beet juice and allow slices to cool. Place beet slices in pickle juice and refrigerate for several hours. The pickle juice gives a tasty "tang" to the nutritious beets. For a milder pickle taste add the beet juice to jar before refrigerating.

Grilled Marinated Zucchini

**1 large clove garlic
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 T. fresh lemon juice
1 teaspoon white-wine vinegar
1/4 cup vegetable oil
2 zucchini, scrubbed**

Mince and mash garlic to a paste with salt. In a small bowl whisk together the garlic paste, lemon juice, vinegar, and pepper to taste and whisk in the oil. In a shallow baking dish large enough to hold the zucchini in one layer, combine the zucchini (halved lengthwise), and the marinade and let the zucchini marinate overnight, covered and chilled, turning several times. Grill the zucchini on an oiled rack set 5-6 inches over coals for 8 minutes and brush with marinade. Turn the zucchini, grill for 6-8 minutes, or until tender, and slice diagonally. (Alternatively, the zucchini may be grilled in a ridged-grill pan.) Serves 4.

Greek Marinade

**1/2 cup olive oil
2 cups diced onions
3/4 cup peeled, diced tomatoes
2 bay leaves, crumbled
1/4 cup lemon juice
2 teaspoons oregano
2 teaspoons salt
3/4 teaspoon black pepper**

Combine all ingredients in blender. Blend until smooth. Use for marinating lamb or beef cubes.

Light Marinade:

**1/2 cup sunflower oil
1/4 cup lemon or lime juice
1 cup chopped parsley or basil
salt and pepper**

Combine all ingredients. Use on vegetables. Marinate for 1-3 hours.

How to Use Honey

In a cake or cookie recipe that calls for other sweetening, the general rule is to substitute 2/3 cup honey for each cup of sugar in the recipe. Also reduce the amount of liquid by one-quarter cup for each cup of honey used. When substituting honey in baked goods, add 1/2 teaspoon baking soda to the recipe for every cup of honey used and bake it at a temperature about 25 degrees lower to prevent over-browning. Place pan or cookie sheet on middle or top oven rack for better results.

In many instances the honey you are using may have a high moisture content. If honey is not tightly covered when storing it may absorb moisture from the air. If this has happened it may be necessary to adjust your recipe slightly to compensate for the extra moisture in order to produce the desired consistency.

The Minnesota Honey Promotion Board would like to recommend that if you are not familiar with conversion, begin with tested honey recipes first. For information and to obtain more recipes, write to "Minnesota Cooking With Honey," Rt 1, Box 408R, Waverly, MN 55390. Your comments and questions are welcome.

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture and the Minnesota Honey Producers do not recommend giving honey to children 1 year of age or younger.

Minnesota State Fair Honey Lemonade

1 6 oz. frozen lemon juice
1/2 pound honey
2-3/4 quarts ice water

Blend ingredients and serve. Great with slices of lemon floating in the bowl. Recipe can be increased easily for serving quantities.

Honey Peanut Butter Icing

This appeals mainly to children. Combine and bring to a boil:

2 tablespoons shortening
2 tablespoons butter
1/4 cup honey

Remove from heat and add:

1/2 cup ground peanuts

Stir until well blended. Spread on a warm cake. Toast very lightly under a broiler, watch carefully.

Tap Into Pure Maple Syrup

Pure maple syrup is made by gathering sap from maple trees in the early spring when daytime temperatures rise above the freezing nighttime temperatures. Sap is collected in traditional buckets, bag systems, tubing systems, or a combination of methods and then boiled in a flat pan or in special maple syrup evaporators. As the sap boils and the water evaporates, the flavor and color of maple syrup develops. The finished syrup is filtered and packed hot in glass, tin, or plastic containers of varying sizes. It takes between 40 and 50 gallons of sap from sugar maple trees to produce one gallon of maple syrup.

You probably already know that maple syrup is great on pancakes and French toast, and that it's great for baking beans. But have you tried vanilla ice cream, nuts and maple syrup? Or adding syrup to the water when boiling ham? Or baking squash with 2 tablespoons of syrup in the cavity?

Pure maple syrup is a "natural" food that contains nothing artificial: no

additives, colorings, or preservatives. You can substitute 1-1/2 cups of maple syrup and 3/8 teaspoon baking soda for a cup of granulated sugar in your recipes. If syrup is replacing all the sugar, decrease liquid by one-half. Reduce the liquid by one-fourth if substituting maple syrup for half the sugar. Maple syrup has only 40 calories per tablespoon. It may be stored at room temperature in unopened containers but should be refrigerated after opening.

Maple Granola Tempting Treats

Mix Well:

14 cups large slow oats
2 cups wheat germ
1 cup sunflower seeds
1 cup sesame seed
2 cups coconut

Add:

3/4 cup pure maple syrup
1/2 cup corn oil
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon vanilla

Mix well and spread thinly in pans. Bake at 275° F for about 20 minutes or until toasted. Watch for burning.

Radish Slaw

- 1/2 pound radishes, trimmed and grated coarse (about 2 cups)
- 3 cups finely shredded cabbage
- 1 cup coarsely grated carrots
- 1/2 cup thinly sliced red onion
- 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- 1/2 teaspoon sugar
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 tablespoons finely chopped fresh coriander, mint or parsley leaves

In a bowl toss together the radishes, the cabbage, the carrots, the onion, the lemon juice, the sugar, the oil, the coriander, and salt and pepper to taste. Serves 4.

Flavored Butters

Flavored Butters are an easy way to dress up ordinary vegetables, meats, or breads.

Herb Butter: Stir 1-1/2 teaspoons fresh thyme, and 1-1/2 teaspoons fresh sage into 1/2 cup softened butter or margerine. Serve with vegetables.

Parsley Butter: Stir 1 tablespoon snipped parsley; 1 teaspoon lemon juice; 3/4 teaspoon fresh savory, crushed; 1/8 teaspoon salt; and dash pepper into 1/2 cup softened butter. Serve with potatoes or bread.

Onion Butter: Stir 1/4 cup finely chopped onion, 2 teaspoons worcestershire sauce, 1/2 teaspoon dry mustard and 1/4 teaspoon pepper into 1/2 cup softened butter. Serve with beef or burgers.

Orange Butter: Stir 1 tablespoon powdered sugar and 1/2 teaspoon grated orange peel into 1/2 cup softened butter. Serve on bread.

Winter Vegetables with Horseradish Dill Butter

- 2 lbs small red potatoes
- 1 lb Brussels sprouts trimmed and halved
- 1 parsnip, peeled and cut into 2-inch sticks
- 1/2 lb carrots, peeled and cut diagonally 1 inch thick
- 2 small turnips, peeled cut into sixths
- 1 stick (1/2 cup) butter
- 1-1/2 tablespoons horseradish
- 1-1/2 tablespoons vinegar
- 1-1/2 tablespoons fresh dill

In a large vegetable steamer set over boiling water steam separately the potatoes, the Brussels sprouts, the parsnips, the carrots, and the turnips for 8 to 12 minutes, or until they are just tender. In a sauce pan melt the butter over moderate heat, stir in the horseradish, the vinegar, the dill, and salt and pepper to taste, and in a large baking pan toss the vegetables with the butter mixture. Keep the vegetables warm and covered, in a 200° F. oven. Serves 6.

Fresh Cucumber Relish

- 3 medium cucumbers
- 1/2 medium onion
- 1/4 cup vinegar
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon dried dillweed

Slice cucumbers in half lengthwise; scoop out seeds and discard. Grind cucumbers and onion using a food grinder with a coarse blade or finely chop by hand; drain. Stir in vinegar, sugar, salt, and dried dillweed. Chill for 8 hours or overnight. Serve on frankfurters or hamburgers. Makes about 4 cups.

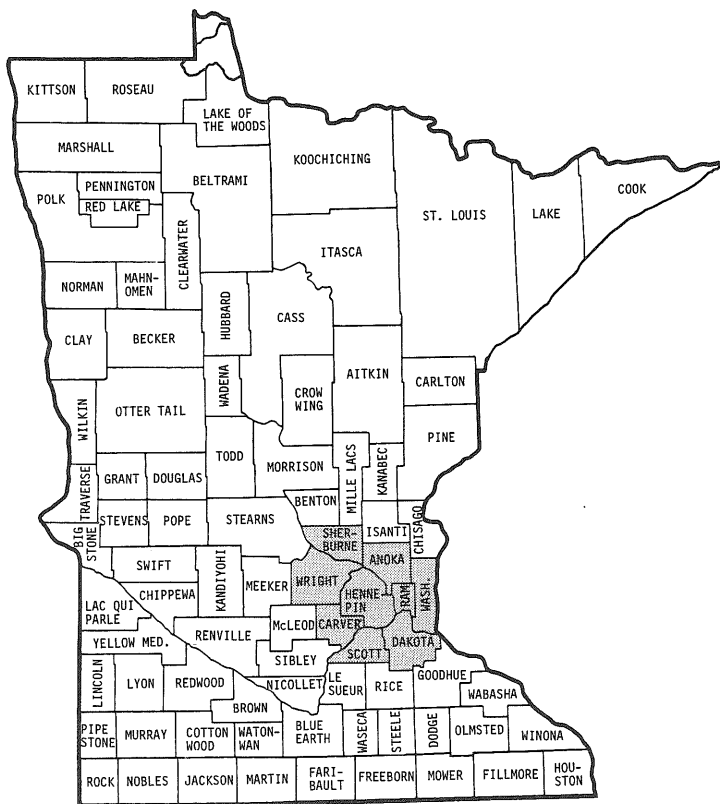

ANOKA COUNTY

Anoka County Farmers' Market

Broccoli, green beans, peas, strawberries, corn, tomatoes, squash, potatoes, apples, honey, eggs, raspberries, grapes, flowers, bedding plants, chickens and rabbits.

Anoka County Farmers' Market

Located at St. Timothy's Catholic Church parking lot, 707 89th Ave, N.E. in Blaine. Open 7 am to noon, Sat, from May 2 through Oct. Also open 2 to 6 pm, Tues, from July 7 through Sept. Bedding plants, flowers, garden produce in season, berries, fruits, honey, eggs, poultry, rabbits, herbs and bulbs.

Anoka County Farmers' Market

Located at Grace Lutheran Church parking lot, 13655 Round Lake Blvd, N.W. in Andover. Open 2 to 6 pm every Wed, from May 6 through Oct. Bedding plants, flowers, fresh vegetables, fruits and berries when in season. Also available are honey, maple syrup, poultry and rabbits. All items are locally grown or produced.

Anoka Rum River Tree Farm

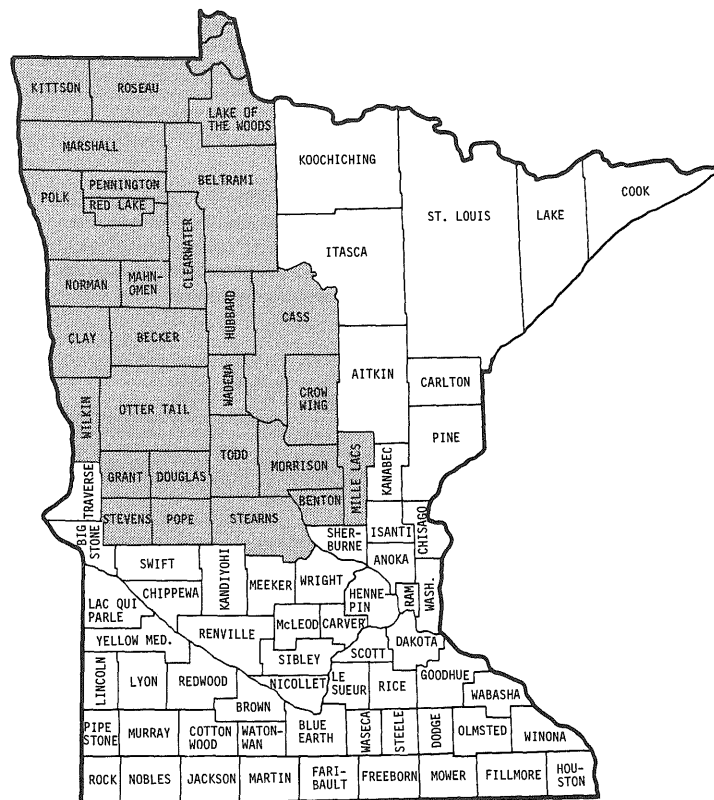

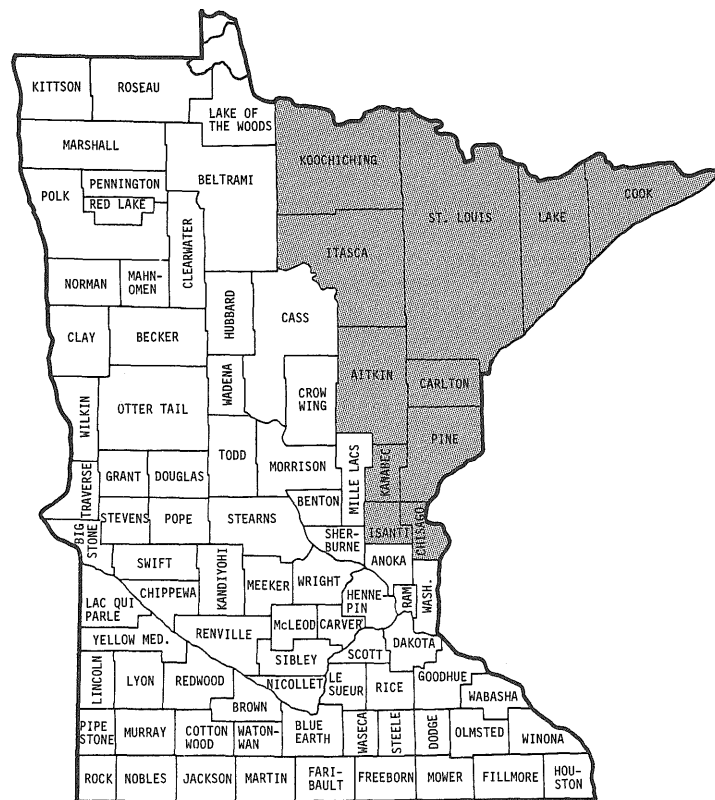

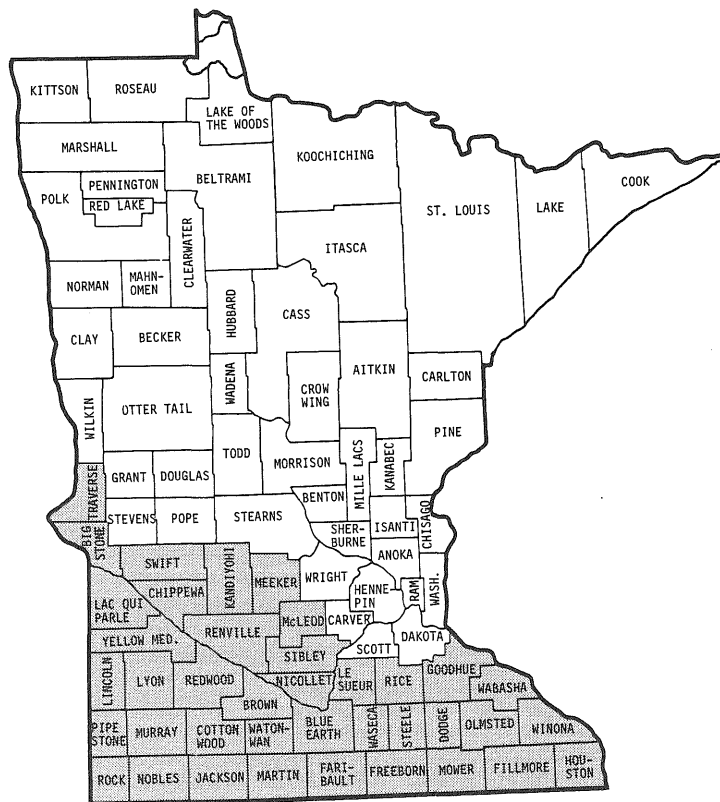
