


You also may find that Minnesota strawberries, carrots and sweet corn

FAMILY FUN

Some Fresh Ideas For You and Your Kids!



BUY FRESH MAPLE SYRUP. Pick up some Minnesota maple syrup to use on your breakfasts of hotcakes, waffles or French toast. Call ahead for a place that will give a tour on how the maple trees are tapped and how the sap is turned into syrup.

CELEBRATE ARBOR DAY. Plant a tree in your yard or attend a local community-sponsored Arbor Day event.

PLANT A FLOWER GARDEN. Work with your children to decide which species of annuals and perennials to include and help them develop a planting schedule. Visit a farmers' market, garden center or nursery as a family to purchase your flowers and other items for planting your garden.



VISIT A PICK-YOUR-OWN BERRY

FARM. The whole family can have fun picking strawberries, raspberries and blueberries. Help the kids in the kitchen to make simple recipes like malts, sundaes or shortcakes. Freeze some for a refreshing winter treat.



SHOP YOUR LOCAL FARMERS'

MARKET. Bring your family to the market weekly to keep track of what's in season. Visit with the growers to learn about production practices. Try at least one new food item each time you visit the market. Here are some suggestions of produce to try:

PLAN A BARBECUE. Get the whole family involved in planning an outdoor barbecue for friends and neighbors using as many products from a farmers' market as you can (some recipe ideas can be found on pages 23-26). Be creative with decorations and games.

VISIT AN APPLE ORCHARD. Take your family to an orchard for pick-your-own or pre-picked apples. Many orchards also host special events and family activities on the weekends. Take the whole day for a scenic drive to view the beautiful fall colors. (Remember to bring along a picnic lunch!)

MAKE FALL DECORATIONS. Visit a pick-your-own pumpkin patch or an apple orchard for pumpkins to paint, carve and decorate for Halloween. Some places also offer scarecrow making, mazes, hayrides and other family activities.

HAVE A MINNESOTA THANKSGIV-

ING. Be creative when planning your Thanksgiving dinner using turkey, wild rice, squash, potatoes and carrots—all from Minnesota. And top your dinner off with Minnesota pumpkin and apple pies topped with Minnesota ice cream.



SKI AN ORCHARD. Some apple orchards offer cross-country skiing. Spend a fun day with your family skiing through the orchard, and then stop back in the warming room for fresh, hot apple cider and baked goods.

Traveling Tips...

BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME

CUT YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS TREE.

Take the family to a choose-and-cut Christmas tree farm to pick out just the right Christmas tree for your holiday celebrations. Pick up some extra pine boughs and garland and make additional decorations for your home.

Some Christmas Tree Varieties

White Spruce, sometimes called the "old fashioned" Christmas tree, has needles 1/2"-1" long that fill every branch with dense foliage.

Balsam Fir, the traditional Christmas tree, has distinctive 1/2"-1 1/2" long dark green needles that are soft to the touch. The aroma of the Balsam Fir is uniquely fragrant.

Colorado Spruce ranges from bluegreen to a rich dark green color and has outstanding needle retention. The needles are about 1" long, stiff and pointed.

Norway Pine (Red Pine) has dark green needles that are clustered and 3"-5" in length. Its excellent needle retention can extend the holiday season into the new year.

Scotch Pine, found in more homes than any other Christmas tree, has 1"-3" needles in clusters that fill every branch with dense foliage.

White Pine, a native to Minnesota, has lacy, dark green needles in clusters of fives that are 2"-4" in length. It has excellent needle retention and will last the entire holiday season.

- Call to verify that the farm or market is open.
- Ask whether the product that you are seeking is available. Also ask about quality and quantity. Different stages of the season affect crop quantity and quality. For example, asparagus is better tasting early in the season, while winter squash is always best after a frost. Crop supply is often limited early in the season, while peak season crops are in large supply. (Prices may be lower in the peak season, too.)
- ➤ Verify directions to the farm or market if it is your first visit.
- ➤ If you plan on bringing children or pets along, make sure they will be welcome. (Not all farms allow children or pets.)
- ➤ If you are picking your own produce, ask if containers are supplied.
- ➤ If you are visiting a farmers' market, you might want to bring along a large bag with handles. Bringing small change or bills is helpful too.

- ➤ If you are planning on picking your own produce, you might want to wear comfortable clothes and bring along sunglasses, sunscreen or tanning lotion, a widebrimmed hat and, perhaps, a picnic lunch.
- ➤ Tell these businesses you found them in the Minnesota Grown Directory of Fresh Produce and More.



Iap Into Purè Maple

Pure syrup is gathering Syrup made by sap from

maple trees in the early spring when daytime temperatures rise above the freezing nighttime temperatures. Sap is collected in traditional buckets, bag systems, tubing systems, or a combination of methods and then boiled in a flat pan or in special maple syrup evaporators. As the sap boils and the water evaporates, the flavor and color of maple syrup develops. The finished syrup is filtered and packed hot in glass, tin, or plastic containers of varying sizes. It takes between 40 and 50 gallons of sap from sugar maple trees to produce one gallon of maple syrup.

You probably already know that maple syrup is great on pancakes and French toast, and that it's great for baking beans. But have you tried vanilla ice cream, nuts and maple syrup? Or adding syrup to the water when boiling ham? Or baking squash with 2 tablespoons of syrup in the cavity?

Pure maple syrup is a "natural" food that contains nothing artificial: no additives, colorings, or preservatives. You can substitute 1-1/2 cups of maple syrup and 3/8 teaspoon baking soda for a cup of granulated sugar in your recipes. If syrup is replacing all the sugar, decrease liquid by one-half. Reduce the liquid by one-fourth if substituting maple syrup for half the sugar. Maple syrup has only 40 calories per tablespoon. It may be stored at room temperature in unopened containers but should be refrigerated after opening.



COOKING

For best results, use recipes developed for using honey.

When you substitute honey for granulated sugar in recipes:

- substitute honey for up to one-half of the sugar. With experimentation, honey can be substituted for all the sugar in some recipes.
- reduce the amount of liquid in the recipe by 1/4 cup for each cup of honey used in baked goods.
- add 1/4 to 3/4 teaspoon baking soda for each cup of honey used.
- reduce oven temperature by 25° F. to prevent over browning of baked goods.
- for easy removal, spray measuring cup with vegetable cooking spray before adding honey.
- honey absorbs & retains moisture readily so baked goods will stay fresh longer.

Please do not give honey to children 1 year of age or younger.

YING

- Select mildly flavored honeys, such as clover, for use in cooking where delicate flavors predominate.
- Use strongly flavored honeys in spreads or other recipes where a distinct honey flavor is desired.

STORAGE TIPS


Store honey at room temperature.

When honey crystallizes, remove lid and place jar in warm water until crystals dissolve. Or, microcook 1 cup of honey in microwave-safe container at HIGH (100%) 2 to 3 minutes or until crystals dissolve; stir every 30 seconds. Do not boil or scorch.






