A Guide to Magazines and Newsletters in the Legislative Reference Library is a directory of the periodicals currently received by the library. These journals cover a wide range of subject areas of interest to legislators and legislative staff members.

This publication is grouped into three separate sections.

The first section is an alphabetical listing of periodicals. Each entry contains a periodical number, title, frequency of publication, and the issuing agency. Several titles have a brief annotation.

The second section contains the Issuing Agency Index and the third section the Subject Headings Index.
