The Legislative Reference Library strives to obtain all state documents of interest to the Legislature, and especially reports mandated by the Legislature. Some may be one-time reports; others must be submitted periodically. A database developed by the library has streamlined the acquisition of mandated reports and has allowed us to track them more efficiently. Agencies mandated to produce reports are contacted regularly and reminded to submit them.

If you would like to know when a particular report is due, or would like a copy of a report we've received, please give us a call. We can also print custom lists by agency, by the mandating law or statute, or by the date reports are due. The report also notes which reports have been received.

PAGE ONE: SUMMER READING

The Legislative Reference Library won't have the latest mystery novel you intended to read on vacation, but we do have several recent books that are great candidates for your summer reading list. They cover important issues in an interesting style, and would add to your knowledge of Minnesota history.

Cook, Charles Ira. *Trapping the Boundary Waters: A Tenderfoot in the Border Country, 1919-1920*. (F612.B73 C66 2000)

- This book is a first hand account of a young man's trapping adventures in the wilds of the early twentieth century Boundary Waters. The author's rich descriptions of outdoor life and of the people he meets on the trap line provide a wonderful insight into an earlier time of this popular recreational area.

Glassner, Barry. *The Culture of Fear: Why Americans are Afraid of the Wrong Things: Crime, Drugs, Minorities, Teen Moms, Killer Kids, Mutant Microbes, Plane Crashes, Road Rage, & So Much More*. New York, NY : Basic Books, c1999. (HN59.2 .G58 1999)

- Sociologist Barry Glassner tries to answer two questions: why are Americans so fearful lately, and why are our fears so often misplaced?

Gray, Virginia, Daniel J. Elazar, and Wyman Spano. *Minnesota Politics & Government*. Lincoln: University of Nebraska Press, c1999. (JK6116 .E43 1999)

- A worthy successor to Royce Hanson's *Tribune of the People*, this book looks at the entirety of Minnesota state government. The section on the legislature takes an in-depth look at the roles of committees, especially conference committees. Overall, the authors find that Minnesota has a healthy economy, a clean and active government, a moralistic culture, and a reputation as a leader and innovator among the 50 states.

Haugerud, Neil. *Jailhouse Stories: Memories of a Small-Town Sheriff*. Minneapolis: University of Minnesota Press, 1999. (HV7979.H38 1999)

- Former legislator Neil Haugerud writes short, colorful vignettes about his tenure as Fillmore County Sheriff in the late 1950s and early 1960s. He lived with his wife and four kids in the same building as the jail; jailbirds and jailbreaks were a part of his family life.

Souder, William. *A Plague of Frogs: The Horrifying True Story*. New York: Hyperion, 2000. (QL668.E2 S737 2000).

- Souder, a science journalist living in Minnesota, states in his introduction, "This much is clear: The frogs are telling us something." Beginning in 1995, frogs with significant deformities have been found in Minnesota. This book tracks the efforts of various researchers and scientists trying to discover the meaning behind the frogs' misfortune.

Tice, D.J. *Minnesota's Twentieth Century: Stories of Extraordinary Everyday People*. Minneapolis : University of Minnesota Press, 1999. (F606.6 .T53 1999)

- Winner of the 1999 Minnesota Book Award for history, D.J. Tice's essays were written "to put flesh on the bones of history." He covers many of the legendary events of the last century - the last hanging, Depression days, prohibition, and the Duluth lynchings, to name a few.

Weiner, Jay. *Stadium Games: Fifty Years of Big League Greed and Bush League Boondoggles*. Minneapolis: University of Minnesota Press, 2000. (GV716 .W43 2000)

- Perfect summer reading for those who just can't get enough of the stadium issue. Jay Weiner, veteran Star Tribune sports writer, took a year's leave to thoroughly examine Minnesota's history with major league sports and the issues surrounding the Minnesota Twins' bid for a new stadium.

PAGE ONE: GENETICALLY MODIFIED FOOD ISSUES

The planting of genetically modified crops has yielded a bumper crop of controversy. Many farmers have accepted the new technology, grateful for the reduced amount of chemicals they use on the pest- and herbicide-resistant plants. But opposition to the unknown effects of the new seeds on food and the environment has been very strong in Europe and is sparking debate in the United States as well. As American consumers and farmers consider their opinions on incorporating genetically modified organisms (GMOs) into their lives, the Legislative Reference Library staff would like to help you get the information you need. The Library just published a new "Resources on Minnesota Issues" guide, *Genetically Modified Food Issues*, on the Library's web site (<http://www.leg.state.mn.us/lrl/issues/gmos.htm>).

The guide begins with a list of arguments made by proponents and opponents of the new technology. PAGE ONE: RACIAL PROFILING

There is growing concern that, in some instances, police officers are using an individual's race or ethnicity as the determining factor in making a traffic stop. This practice is commonly referred to as racial profiling. Federal, state, and local governments are attempting to determine the extent of this practice. In Minnesota, the Minneapolis and St. Paul police departments have started collecting additional traffic-stop data and the State Patrol will likely follow suit. Efforts to develop a statewide policy for Minnesota have begun as well. A state task force, coordinated by the Department of Public Safety, is currently examining the issue and is expected to make recommendations to the 2001 legislature. The Federal Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998 provides the framework for a national workforce preparation and employment system designed to meet both the needs of the nation's businesses and the needs of job seekers and those who want to further their careers. The Act provides that each state will establish both state and local workforce investment boards. The state board will help the Governor develop a five-year strategic plan describing statewide workforce development activities, explaining how the requirements of the Act will be implemented, and outlining how special population groups will be served. On June 23, 2000 the United States Department of Labor approved Minnesota's State Unified Plan. Services under WIA began on July 1, 2000.

Our access to newspapers has grown by leaps and bounds in the past few years. Although we don't get every newspaper in the state in print, we have many ways to help you get articles. In some cases, this access is even available from your desk. You can search for articles yourself, or of course you can call us for help at 296-8338. We're happy to help you find what you need, or do the work for you.

Online access to full text articles from the *Pioneer Press*, *Star Tribune*, *Duluth News Tribune* and *Grand Forks Herald* is available to legislative staff through our subscription to Newslibrary. You may search these newspapers by keyword and retrieve the full text of articles from your office or anywhere else within the legislative campus. Simply access the library's Intranet at <http://www.leg.state.mn.us/intranet/> and choose "Newspapers" from the menu on the left side.

This same link gives access to additional full text newspapers, available from Bell and Howell via MnLink. Select "Newspapers--Full Text" to search the following newspapers: *Wall Street Journal* 1986-present, *Washington Post* 1988-present, *Los Angeles Times* 1988-present, the *New York Times* current 90 days in full text and abstracts 1986-present, and the *Star Tribune* 1986-present. You can search all of these newspapers at once or search each newspaper individually.

The library also receives 31 newspapers in print, a local and national collection. A list is available on the Intranet, including hyperlinks to Web sites where available. Some newspapers have the full text of their articles, including archives of older articles. Our *Links to the World – Media* page, <http://www.leg.state.mn.us/lrl/links/media.htm>, provides access to Web sites for additional local, national and international newspapers.

Last, but not least, our collection of newspaper clipping files by subject include articles from the *Star Tribune*, the *St. Paul Pioneer Press*, and many greater Minnesota newspapers. Filed by detailed topical category codes, the coverage dates back to 1970. We also maintain clipping files on Minnesota legislators, filed by legislative district number; the coverage dates back to 1972. Personality files include information on prominent Minnesotans, members of Congress, former Minnesota legislators and selected national figures.

PAGE ONE: PRIVACY

Personal privacy and data control issues are increasingly drawing the general public's attention. Sophisticated electronic technology is available to government and the private sector to streamline the collection and the sharing of data on individuals. The use of cookies and other tracking software may provide companies with information to create customized services, but it may be data users don't want them to have - or at least don't want shared. States are in the difficult position of trying to protect citizens, but at the same time ensuring economic vitality tied to the Internet.

The privacy arena is broad: legislation relating to telecommunications, financial institutions' sharing of customer data, medical records privacy, government records, and telemarketing has been introduced in the last year in Minnesota alone. An interesting discussion of the scope of private sector and public privacy issues is found in a National Governors' Association task force report, "Privacy- Building the Public Trust." The report is available online at <http://www.nga.org/cda/files/000620PRIVACY.pdf>.

As the 2001 legislature gets ready to consider another round of privacy related bills, we've prepared some resources to aid those researching the topic. PAGE ONE: CONCEALED WEAPONS

Currently in Minnesota, a person, other than a law enforcement officer, may carry a pistol only when in possession of a "permit to carry." (Minn. Stat. 624.714) These "permits to carry" are issued at the discretion of the local law enforcement authorities. A movement to change the permit application process from "discretionary" to "shall issue" has gained strength in the last few years. A "shall issue" application process would require the granting of permits to all applicants who meet minimum requirements.

Since 1987, starting with Florida, there has been a dramatic increase in the number of states changing over to a "shall issue" permit system. Over 30 states now have "shall issue" concealed weapon laws. Vermont allows the carrying of a concealed weapon without a permit.

During the 2001 Minnesota Legislative Session, this issue was debated at length and will most likely return in future sessions. A selection of recent items on concealed firearms is listed below.
