REPORT OF THE STATE CANVASSING BOARD

STATE OF MINNESOTA, DEPARTMENT OF STATE.

We, Mike Holm, Secretary of State, Andrew Holt, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Charles Loring, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Albin S. Pearson, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District, and Levi M. Hall, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on September 18, 1942, the certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the 1942 Primary Election, and we have prepared therefrom a statement of the whole number of votes cast at said election for the office of United States Senator in Congress (for term beginning Jan. 3, 1943, and ending Jan. 3, 1949), for United States Senator in Congress (for term beginning Nov. 3, 1942, and ending Jan. 3, 1943), for the several State Officers, Representatives in Congress, Judges of the District Court, Senators and Representatives in the Legislature, and we have specified the names of the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast, which said statement is as follows:
