REPORT OF THE STATE CANVASSING BOARD

STATE OF MINNESOTA,

DEPARTMENT OF STATE.

We, Mike Holm, Secretary of State, Thos. F. Gallagher, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Oscar R. Knutson, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Kenneth Gray Brill, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District, and D. E. LaBelle, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on September 26, 1950, the certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the 1950 Primary Election, and we have prepared therefrom a statement of the whole number of votes cast at said election held on the 12th day of September, 1950, for the several State Officers, Representatives in Congress, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, State Senators, and Representatives in the Legislature, and we have specified the names of the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast, which statement is as follows:
