Executive Summary

The total amount of Grants and Gifts Estimated and Received is \$14,237 less than state fiscal year 2022. The decrease was due to the combination of an increase of the New Venture and the Sauer Family Foundation Grants, decrease for Turnaround Art Grants, and no grant for DHS Parent Aware.
