This letter is to notify you of direct appropriation transfers approved by Minnesota Management & Budget (MMB) in the quarter that ended December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. All transfers are general fund, unless otherwise noted.

This letter is notification as required by Laws 2019, First Special Session, chapter 9, article 14, section 12. This notification also complies with the requirement for the Department to report transfers in Minn. Stat. §256.01, Subdivision 41, clause (2).

You can find the legal authority and accounting detail for each transfer itemized in this letter by the corresponding reference item number in the **Summary of Accounting Detail for Approved Direct Appropriation Transfers** attached to this letter. Service level agreements that were authorized between October and December 2022 are conveyed under a separate required quarterly report to the Legislature.

## FY 2023 Transfers – 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter

- 1. Two transfers were made from BACT 11 GF Operations to MN.IT @ DHS, one for \$54,000 and the other \$3,283,000.
- 2. A \$268,025 transfer was made from a Department of Corrections invoice to BACT 33 MA Grants.
- 3. A series of 10 transfers totaling \$5,520,000 were made between admin accounts for technical budget setting, administrations within DHS supporting each other, transfers to distribute operating adjustments, and transfers associated with FTEs and other administrative costs:
  - \$404,180 from BACT 14 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$895,843 from BACT 15 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$770,000 from BACT 13 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$652,000 from BACT 13 GF Operations to BACT 15 GF Operations
  - \$14,000 from BACT 13 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$134,000 from BACT 15 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$326,000 from BACT 12 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$1,052,000 from BACT 13 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$357,000 from BACT 14 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$722,000 from BACT 15 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
  - \$192,977 from BACT 14 GF Operations to BACT 11 GF Operations
- 4. A \$60,000 transfer from BACT 11 GF Operations to the Governor's Office per the Joint Powers Agreement.
