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## ALLEGED MISCONDUCT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 – STATEWIDE

Minn. Stat. 626.8457, subd. 3, requires Chief Law Enforcement Officers (CLEOs) to annually report summary data regarding the investigation and disposition of cases involving alleged unprofessional conduct by peace officers based on department's allegations of misconduct policy (Minn. R. 6700.2200). Department's policy should minimally require the complainant to complete and sign a citizen complaint form for the complaint to be considered filed. Policy should also allow the CLEO the discretion to determine whether or not the facts alleged require a formal investigation.
