

Transfer Students

The Minnesota Transfer Students dashboard summarizes the transfer patterns between year 1 and year 2 for students enrolled as New Entering Freshmen. The transfer data is disaggregated by fiscal year and term of entry, institution and sector of origin, institution and sector of destination, race and ethnicity, sex, age, financial aid status, and residency.

The Minnesota Transfer Students dashboard is a legislatively mandated report under Minnesota Statutes 136A.057 Student Transfer Reporting. Please note that this report only includes students formally transferring as indicated by the college registering the student as a "New Transfer Student".

This group excludes:

- 1. Students earning credit from PSEO, Concurrent Enrollment, Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, CLEP, military service, or prior learning assessment if they have never enrolled as a New Entering Freshmen student in a prior term at a different institution,
- 2. Students enrolling in courses at more than one institution in the same term without formally transferring, and
- 3. Students completing a credential at their first institution prior to formally transferring, as required by the legislation.

About this Report

The OHE Transfer Report dashboard is a legislatively mandated report under Minnesota Statutes 136A.057 Student Transfer Reporting.

This dashboard summarizes the movement of students between institutions after their first year of college. This report only includes students recognized as formal transfer students <u>and did not complete a credential prior</u> to transferring. Students taking classes at more than 1 college without formally transferring are not included. The transfer data is disaggregated by institution and sector of origin, institution and sector of destination, race and ethnicity, sex, age, financial aid status, and residency.

2021 Minnesota Statutes 136A.057 STUDENT TRANSFER REPORTING.

(a) The commissioner must report on the office's website summary data on students who, within the most recent academic year, withdrew from enrollment without completing a degree or credential program at a public postsecondary institution in Minnesota. The summary data must include whether the students who withdrew transferred to another institution and the institutions transferred to and from.

(b) Summary data must be aggregated by postsecondary institution and degree or credential program. Summary data must be disaggregated by race, ethnicity, Pell eligibility, and age.

(c) The commissioner must post the initial data on the office's website on or before February 15, 2022, and must update the data at least annually thereafter.

Inclusions and Exclusions

Please note that this report only includes students formally transferring as indicated by the college registering the student as a "New Transfer Student". Data for this report only includes students enrolled at Minnesota institutions participating in state financial aid as required under Minnesota Statutes section 136A.121 subd. 18.

This group excludes:

(1) Students earning credit from PSEO, Concurrent Enrollment, Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, CLEP, military service, or prior learning assessment if they have never enrolled as a New Entering Freshmen student in a prior term at a different institution,

(2) Students enrolling in courses at more than one institution in the same term without formally transferring, and

(3) Students completing a credential at their first institution prior to formally transferring, as required by the legislation.

Other information

This is a legislatively mandated dashboard. As requested by Minnesota Statutes, section 3.197, this dashboard cost approximately \$6,874.13 to prepare, including staff time. ..
