

ACADEMIC LEAGUE



Product Development: Input from customer? Needs assessment survey to be conducted during April statewide. Cycle time to produce product or service: no process in place. On-time delivery-behind schedule in new product development, have improved existing products. No defects or rework; errors corrected as noted. Benchmark comparisons? Center for School Change assuming some market share. Breadth of product line to be expanded for FY95. Development underway, will pilot some new products and services in FY95; study pricing issues vs costs for FY 96. Need to develop alternate deliveries to sustain needs within budget restraints.

Personal Sales: # new customers - 37
 # not returned - 8-Public, 5-Nonpublic
 # dropped-primary reason offered-lack of funds (refer to attachment)
 100% of potential market contacted directly in 67% of the state
 # sold vs. goal - renewals-190, new-37
 Flow of sales ontrack against time? On schedule through January, new sales drastically dropped off in February. Need to reduce sales force variation. Benchmark comparisons (competition and best?) High School League? Difficult to compare sales because HSL membership is obligatory for participation, thus sales approach is minimal.

Delivery of Service: On-time delivery-generally good, some variance statewide some customers required minimal service, others additional service. (Profiles, media workshops)
Time of year (cycle) met needs-good thus far, still working on 93-94 profile updates; sometimes difficult to collect data. No defects in product or service-very minimal after information is collected. Could use better technology. Late/not received-generally requested but variance in South Central area. Management of complaints-immediate response to customer.
Benchmark comparisons-MSHSL?

Promotion / advertising: Need more statewide "hoopla" in addition to sales contacts. Customer needs vs product characteristics-presently working on determination of real customer needs via needs assessment. Marketed on-time to targeted customer: developing improved timeline, cycle for FY95. Product has good name recognition: has improved vastly since beginning of Academic League; customers are generally aware of services.

Project Management: Timelines set and met; budget on target. Staff active, results oriented, good leadership. Need to transition to volunteer-driven activity; losig market share due to lag in product development; need to accelerate impact measurement.

IMPACT GOALS:


School culture will value academic achievement

PERFORMANCE:

Process for collection of data initiated which will communicate performance against goals and begin a benchmarking process; year-to-year, member/region and member/state comparisons. Data collection behind schedule.

PARTNERS FOR QUALITY: SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT



Product Development: Continues to improve. Strategic options for continuing sites are identified, though not yet in place. Training options and schedule for new sites being refined. Further exploration of best practices and policy/advocacy services needed.

Personal Sales: Strong concentration signing previous contacts while still cultivating new contacts. have not met goal. Volunteer consultant recruitment on target.

Delivery of Service: Have had service contact (phone, minimally) with 100% of sites. Still a need for consistent orientation and training format, as well as consultant orientation.

Promotion / advertising: Most effective at national and specific state levels. Local outreach needs to refocus efforts with less emphasis on paper generation and more effort on targeted group and personal contacts.

Project Management: With departure of co-coordinator, areas for improvement have been identified and will be addressed with the hire of Project Manager. Budget on target.

IMPACT GOALS:


Education in Minnesota will improve toward world class performance (quality results) which meet the needs of business, industry, next level of education and communities (external customer validation)

1. Increase # schools using quality process to transform systems performance
2. # schools will complete self-assessment of systems

PERFORMANCE:

None of the goals have been met, but some improvement toward goals is evident in #2 and #3.

PARTNERS FOR QUALITY: STATE AND NATIONAL ADVOCACY



Product Development: Platform developed - using Baldrige framework to direct policy decisions toward establishing and meeting world class standards for learning and management has been noted, praised in multiple sectors, including media.

Personal Sales: Adequate, but need to add volunteers and increase efforts March - June, 1994

Promotion / advertising: Adequate

Project Management: Adequate now, but to involve more people, need a tighter process.

IMPACT GOALS:


Education policy in Minnesota will be directed toward establishing world class standards and a process for attaining these standards.

1. Policymakers will understand and use quality process (Baldrige approach) to make decisions and provide incentives for school improvement
2. Business, government and education groups will work with MAEF to advocate for world class performances.

PERFORMANCES:

Understanding and awareness are increasing at both state and national level, but this will continue to demand time. Four key groups are moving; need to involve more.

PARTNERS FOR QUALITY: NATIONAL CONFERENCE



Project Development: An above average conference program has been developed.

Delivery of Service: Not available at this time (looks goods!)

Personal Sales: Results to date = 900 vs 1200 goal

Promotion / advertising: Good recognition and response; used ads and releases.

Project Management: Excellent; all 2000 details on schedule; good team; budget always an issue

IMPACT GOALS:


Establish quality as a strategy for transforming schools toward meeting world class graduation outcomes and for organizing communities to meet the national education goals; establish visibility for MAEF and for Minnesota Partners for Quality Initiative.

PERFORMANCE:

To date, project has resulted in progress toward these goals.

MINNESOTA 2000

Product Development: A clearinghouse survey implemented to develop a data base to be shared among communities; contacted to establish ways to collaborate on promotion of MN Goals 2000



Delivery of service: Cards mailed to "gap" sites ; status update requested. Data received indicates 50 communities are active. Bulletin mailed with resources, services available. Access to tapes on Goals 2000 satellite broadcasts also promoted and available.

Personal sales: No new sites contacted. Still need an action plan. Initiated use of local quality councils and will use Wal-Mart as a vehicle.

Promotion/advertising: MN Goals 2000 Bulletin printed and 4,000 copies distributed to existing MN 2000 mailing list. Contact with Wal-Mart to increase visibility through handouts is planned.

Project management: Beginning to take shape but needs to devote more time to project.

IMPACT GOALS:


Minnesota communities will develop and deploy plans to improve education in their local schools toward meeting the six national education goals.

1. Increase activity level of current MN 2000 communities.
2. Add # new communities.
3. Add # new volunteers (non-educators)
4. Increase awareness and recognition of national education goals.
5. Establish baseline performance for each community and for state.
6. Improve performance at state and local level.

PERFORMANCE:

(None of these activities have been deployed)

GOVERNOR'S SCHOLAR'S



Product Development: Strong curriculum in place for Governor's Scholar's program; Alums need to develop a project plan and focus a quickly (overdue) but underway.

Delivery of Service: Summer Institute was above average but over budget. Winter Reunion served 75% of Scholars

Personal Sales: Need to improve here. Governor's Scholars performance was below goal last year. Sales activity for FY 95 currently underway.

Promotion/advertising: Good name recognition.

Project management: Needs improvement to meet timelines; establish plan and use volunteers -results - over budget.


IMPACT GOALS:

Create in Minnesota a cadre of young leaders capable of addressing community issues in culturally sensible ways:

PERFORMANCE:

Program good; need to improve outreach #'s and gain on time lines (Catch up) Stay within budget constraints.

GOVERNOR'S SCHOLARS ALUMNI



Product Development: Need a membership services plan to make alumni association self-sufficient. Directory of Scholar alumni developed; need to begin selling a different product to the same market.

Delivery of Service: Directory is updated but production and distribution requires start-up money from membership fees.

Personal Sales: Improvement needed (ie sales plan). An aggressive recruitment of alumni is needed to convince alumni how the alumni association can benefit them with a social /career networking opportunity and contribute to the growth of the program through alumni recruitment. Currently have 42 alumni representing nine years of the program on the alumni committee.

Promotion and Advertising: A pilot alumni recruiting effort in SE MN is underway. The alum contacted schools by phone who are not currently a member of the Academic League or being recruited by current Scholars. Very time consuming, some name recognition of the program, but encountered unwillingness on the part of guidance counselor to partake in another, also heard some good name recognition.

Project Management: Needs a plan and strategy with timelines set, so all volunteers are used equally and feel the program benefits them as well as an opportunity to give back to the program.


IMPACT GOALS:

Create alumni group to support MAEF and Governor's Scholars objectives.

PERFORMANCE:

Poor to date. Need to begin generating income through membership and provide services to alumni (directory, newsletters, involvement with current institutes, steering committee, workshops, social gatherings).

GATHERING OF CHAMPIONS



Product Development: Date set for State Fair in August; work plan and budget needs to be developed; planning team being assembled; planning meetings will begin in May. Despite many details to be worked out, this should shape up nicely over the spring and summer. Need to accelerate planning.

Delivery of Service: N/A at this point

Personal sales: Press releases out to statewide weelies and educational media; pitching story to media at meetings in March and April. Still plenty to do. Sales to teachers to nominate students is lagging. 25 students nominated to date.

Promotion/Advertising: Articles with coupon registration form in *Catalyst* and other educational publications are yielding registrations and some calls and questions. Letters of invitation going out to some student nominees at year end event. (MN Science Academy, MN Young Inventors) Q and A developed to ensure consistency in responding in responding to phone calls. Information kits will be presented to Academic League Council members at their meeting April 22. Need to promote to Academic League affiliate members and school member contacts.

IMPACT GOALS


Create awareness of MAEF and focus public attention on academic achievement as a positive concept.

1. Increase # participants to 1000 +
2. Increase media attention
3. Increase recognition of MAEF by targeted audiences.

PERFORMANCE

No performance to date

MEDIA SHARE/PUBLIC AWARENESS AND OUTREACH



Product Development: MAEF media relations plan roughed out with top priority being given to major media in the metro area; implementation underway. National conference "hit list" developed; press conference planned; implementation underway. Media training designed and delivered. PR strategy/timeline needs attention. Met with Publicity Central to explore ideas for using electronic media for news releases; advisories. Will use for national conference public relations. Have begun to "customize" pitches as per meetings.

Delivery of Service: MAEF media relations/national conference: have met with Strib/Pioneer Press editorial boards; KMSP new manager; education beat reporter from Pioneer Press; Strib columnist. One good article in major media so far. Good interest, unique opportunities, resulting from meetings. Media relations training developed.

Personal Sales: MAEF media relations: all first tier media representatives have been contacted and asked to meet with us; six meetings have taken place to date, we continue to push for opportunities. National conference: Media reps on national conference "hit list" received materials and follow-up phone calls.

Promotion/Advertising: MAEF media relations plan roughed out with top priority being given to major media in the metro area; implementation underway. Looking into a booth at Mall of America during Futurefest in April. Promoting MAEF and national conference simultaneously at this point. Post conference, will focus on second and third tier media in greater Minnesota. Plans need refinement.

IMPACT GOALS:


MAEF Will become a household word and academic excellence as a concept will be visibly valued.

1. Regional: use Academic League members to improve linkages. Develop media kits and train members. Develop a speakers bureau to target service clubs.
2. State: establish schedule of meetings with major media contacts and implement. Recognize good efforts from media.
3. National: use national conference as vehicle to increase awareness.
4. Increase # articles and major coverage.
5. Implement a campaign to reach targeted audiences.

PERFORMANCE:

Baseline survey was completed and needs additional analysis before implementing a media campaign. Moving on schedule /objectives - need to focus on cultivating major media contacts and establishing regional presence. Local/regional efforts underway. Survey indicated about 15% of respondents were familiar with MAEF.

FUND DEVELOPMENT



Product Development : Four campaigns have been developed and are underway: annual fund; endowment; corporations and foundations; and national conference. A fifth campaign targeting small businesses has just begun, and a sixth to target service clubs is only in discussion phase. Resource constraints have limited refinements in most of these activities.

Delivery of Service: Donors have been thanked and recognized and kept informed of MAEF activities.

Personal Sales: Implemented via endowment and corporate campaigns. Need to improve at annual fund level, generate more prospects and connect donors better with MAEF.

Promotion and Advertising: No activity

Management: FY95 plan developed.

IMPACT GOALS:


Improve MAEF's revenue mix and fund ongoing operations.

PERFORMANCE:

Generally on target, but will lose some donors in FY95. Corporate and foundation campaign has exceeded goal.

VOLUNTEER DEVELOPMENT

Product Development: Audit completed and plans underway to establish a system for recruiting, managing volunteer personnel. Need to continue improvement; increase involvement of present volunteers



Delivery of Service: Recognized volunteers in Catalyst; all staff engaged in effort.

Personal Sales: 500+ volunteers identified; need sales plan to recruit more.

Promotion and Advertising: Need to develop a campaign for FY95

IMPACT GOALS:

MAEF will become a household word and people involvement will increase.

PERFORMANCE:

No results to date. Public awareness survey indicated about 15% of respondents were familiar with MAEF.
