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Report Cost

As required by Minn. Stat. 3.197, this report cost approximately \$946.75 to prepare.

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Introduction

In Minnesota, a teacher providing instruction in a public school or charter school must hold a license aligned to the field and grade level taught. The Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board is responsible for issuing licenses and for collecting and reporting data on the number of licensed teachers in Minnesota as well as their assignments. 2

Following extensive legislative changes in 2017, a new tiered licensure system went into effect on July 1, 2018, which created four different tiered licenses for teachers. Legacy license types were extended an additional year, resulting in full transition to tiered licensure beginning on July 1, 2019.

As required by Minnesota Rule 8710.0310, subpart 8, this report summarizes the number and percentage of Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 licenses as well as the out-of-field permissions (OFP)³ and innovative program permissions (IPP)⁴ held by teachers actively working in a classroom or holding an unexpired license at the end of the 2021-2022 academic year.

The data tables included in this report are organized by race and ethnicity, licensure field, and districts and charter schools. Additionally, this report includes several data tables that provide additional teacher licensure data by overall percentages, proportions, and regions. Now that three years have passed since fulling transitioning to the tiered licensure system, the data in this report better reflects the changing landscape of Minnesota's teaching profession.

The data in these tables comes from several different sources, including the legacy teacher licensure system, the new teacher licensure database, and the Staff Automated Reporting (STAR) system. These systems capture data at different times and of different populations, meaning that many totals are not consistent across data tables. Context and notes are provided for each data table in their respective sections.

Additionally, race/ethnicity data continues to be drawn from two data sources, one reported by the district (STAR) and the other by the teacher (Educators Online). While PELSB staff is more confident in the accuracy of the race/ethnicity data in this report, improved data collection tools are needed to ensure policy decisions are made using the best information available.

Finally, the information reported from districts (STAR) represents a snapshot in time for that district. Information reported through licensure applications (Educators Online) can reflect a changing landscape over an academic year as an individual may switch tiers mid-year. This may cause some minor inconsistencies within the data presented.

Race and Ethnicity of Tier Licensed Teachers and Permission Holders

Overview

There were just under 113,000 teachers licensed in Minnesota at the end of the 2021-22 school year. The data provided in this section highlights how the race and ethnicity of teachers varies by tiered license type and permission type. Table 1 provides data on the race and ethnicity of teachers who held tiered licenses, OFPs, and IPPs during the 2021-2022 school year. This data is a snapshot, meaning it reflects licenses held as of spring 2022. Table 2 provides the same data as a percentage of the total within each license or permission category. Table 3 provides the same data as a percentage of the total within each race/ethnicity category. Table 2a (a new table) provides the percentage increase or decrease in each category from Table 2 in the Tiered Licensure and Permissions Report 2021 and Table 2 in this report.

Highlights of the following tables still help identify important information and trends around tiered licensure:

- A decrease in "No race/ethnicity provided" category: The majority of race/ethnicity data comes through districts (STAR report) and thus is often more complete when licensed teachers start taking on assignments and are reported in STAR. The decrease in this category translated primarily to increases in the "white, not of Hispanic origin" category.
- A decrease of over 1,000 overall teachers, with the decreases entirely within teachers holding a tier 4 license and an increase in teachers holding a tier 1, tier 2, or tier 3 license.
- In almost all race/ethnicity categories other than white, the percentage of how many teachers are holding each tier decreases from tier 1 to tier 4. Of these, "Black, not of Hispanic origin" is the most pronounced difference between the number of teachers who hold a tier 1 versus a tier 4.
- Individuals of color continue to be more represented among Tier 1 and Tier 2 educators, identifying the need for greater access to professional development and pathways to licensure, such as teacher preparation or the licensure via portfolio.
- Since 2021, the percentage of teachers of color have increased in every tier, with an overall 0.5% increase.
- While tiered licensure is playing a role in filling some gaps, particular when attrition among tier 4 teachers high, it remains a very small percentage of the overall teaching force. (Table 1)
- Special Education licensure areas remains the highest overall percentage of tier 1 teachers. (Table 6)
- While charter schools represent less than 9% of overall teaching workforce, they represent nearly half of the tier 1 teachers. (Table 10)
- 57% of teachers holding a tier 1 license are in Region 11 (7-county metro area), higher than the percentage of the overall teacher workforce. (Table 12)
- As in previous years, all economic development regions have very similar use of teachers on all tier levels. (Table 13)

Note: For the 2021 Tiered Licensure Report, the table below, Table 3a, (previously Table 2a) was calculated by comparing the percentage racial makeup of each tier as listed in Table 2 – simply the percent *difference* between 2020 and 2021. This year, the percent *change* was calculated by dividing the increase or decrease in number of teachers in a specific racial category who hold a specific tiered license by the total number of educators of that race/ethnicity who held that same tiered license during the 2020-2021 school year. This change was made to better reflect the impact of tiered licensure on educators of color and Indigenous educators. For better comparative analysis, we are including a table (Table 3b) using this same method to calculate the percent change in racial diversity of tiered licenses from 2020 to 2021.

Licensure Fields

Overview

The "licensure field" describes the content area that a teacher is authorized to teach. Each license and permission identifies an applicable licensure field.

To calculate the number of teachers who are licensed in a particular licensure field, the data must include duplicate counts of teachers if they held more than one license. Additionally, licensure field categories have changed frequently over the last twenty years - meaning that many licensure areas listed below are a combination of multiple license types (see Appendix 1 for definitions of each licensure field identified here).

The licensure fields with the largest number of licenses remained somewhat consistent across tiers, with a much higher proportion of special education fields and career and technical education fields in Tier 1, Tier 2, and OFPs. These areas remain remarkably consistent with the previous year. The largest fields of tiered license holders include:

1. Tier 1

- a. Academic and Behavioral Strategist
- b. Elementary Education
- c. Career and Technical Education
- d. Emotional Behavioral Disorders
- e. Physical Education

2. Tier 2

- a. Elementary Education
- b. Academic and Behavioral Strategist
- c. Emotional Behavioral Disorders
- d. Mathematics
- e. Social Studies

3. Tier 3

- a. Early Childhood
- b. Elementary Education
- c. Academic and Behavioral Strategist
- d. Social Studies
- e. Communication Arts/Literature

4. Tier 4

- a. Elementary Education
- b. Communication Arts/Literature
- c. Social Studies
- d. Early Childhood
- e. Learning Disabilities

Meanwhile, the licensure fields with the largest number of OFPs included:

1. OFPs

- a. Career and Technical Education
- b. Academic and Behavioral Strategist
- c. Emotional Behavioral Disorders
- d. Autism Spectrum Disorders
- e. Early Childhood Special Education

Proportion of Licensed Teachers in Each Licensure Field, by Tier

The proportion of individuals on a tier within a licensure field differs substantially - ranging from 100 percent of Somali language teaching licenses being Tier 1 licenses (Minnesota just approved its first teacher preparation programs for the Somali language license in 2022) to the majority of licensure fields having less than one percent of Tier 1 licenses. Similar variation occurs within each tier. While some instances are a matter of proportion or a matter of licensure restrictions (for example, a Tier 1 license cannot be issued to a school nurse), a few takeaways can be seen in the data:

- 1. World languages and career and technical education licensure areas remain the highest percentage of Tier 1 and Tier 2 licenses within their field. Notably, there are no, or very few, licensure programs in Minnesota aligned to each of these licensure fields.
- 1. The only licensure areas where more than 25% of teachers are on a Tier 1 or a Tier 2 license are licensure areas without teacher preparation programs in Minnesota
- 2. Special education licensure areas represent nearly a third (32%) of all tier 1 licenses and only slightly less (30%) of all tier 2 licenses.

Table 6 provides the proportion of tiered licenses within each licensure field.

Tier 1 Licenses, Tier 2 Licenses, and Out-of-Field Permissions Issued to Licensure Fields

Similar to Table 6, the data in Table 7 takes total numbers within Tier 1, Tier 2, and OFPs and considers them as a proportion of the total licenses issued within that license or permission (the column totals 100%, whereas Table 6 the row totals 100%). Of the total number of Tier 1 licenses, Tier 2 licenses, and OFPs issued, the largest proportion tended to fall into special education fields (one-third of all Tier 1 licenses), and an increasingly high percentage of Tier 2 licenses in Elementary Education (nearly one in five Tier 2 licenses).

Table 7 provides the overall percentages of Tier 1 licenses, Tier 2 licenses, and OFPs issued to the various licensure fields.

Numbers of Tier Licensed Teachers and Permission Holders at School Districts, Charter Schools, and Other Educational Institutions

Tracking where Minnesota teachers work is a difficult process because only Tier 1 licenses, Tier 2 licenses, OFPs and IPPs are attached to specific school districts. Meanwhile, Tier 3 and Tier 4 licensed teachers do not have licenses assigned to a district. Rather, the licenses are mobile, meaning that teachers can use their licenses to teach at any public school in Minnesota.

PELSB tracks where licensed teachers work using the Staff Automated Reporting (STAR) system. This reflects a snapshot of employment at the time of the data collection and does not represent changes in position or hiring before or after the district report.

Overview

During the 2021-2022 school year, Minnesota public school districts, charter schools, and other educational institutions employed 80,357 teachers throughout the state.⁵ Of those teachers, about 96 percent held a Tier 3 or Tier 4 license.

The number of licensed teachers school districts employed ranged from Minneapolis Public School District employing more nearly 3800 teachers to several charter schools and educational cooperatives employing five or fewer teachers.

The public school districts employing the largest number of licensed teachers included:

- 1. Minneapolis Public School District
- 2. St. Paul Public School District
- 3. Anoka-Hennepin Public School District
- 4. Rosemount-Apple Valley-Eagan
- 5. Osseo Public School District

The charter schools employing the largest number of licensed teachers included:

- 1. Pine to Prairie Cooperative Center
- 2. STEAM Academy Charter School
- 3. Aspire Academy Charter School
- 4. Cross River Charter School
- 5. Birch Grove Community School

The districts employing the largest number of Tier 3 and Tier 4 teachers were the same districts hiring the largest number of total teachers. The largest employers of Tier 1 and Tier 2 teachers tended to be larger school districts. However, four charter schools and one intermediate district rank among the top ten employers of Tier

1 teachers. While Table 8 identifies raw numbers, Table 9 provides tiers held as a proportion of teachers within the district.

The number of districts that do not utilize tier 1 licensure remains high (50%) but is slightly lower than 2021 (54%). The number of districts that do not utilize tier 1 licensure also decreased from 19% in 2021 to 17% in 2022.

Table 8 provides additional data on the number of Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 licensed teachers that school districts, charter schools, and other educational institutions employed in the 2020-2021 school year. The table also provides data on the number of OFPs and IPPs issued to districts throughout the entire school year.

Between 2020 and 2021, the number of public school districts and charter schools increased by five. Any individual a district or school hired after the STAR data collection period would not be included in this table. The OFP and IPP data comes from records kept by PELSB's licensing division and was current as of spring 2022.

The data table for the Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 licenses contains headcount - meaning that individuals are counted only once in each district or school. The OFP and IPP data is of the total number of OFPs or IPPS issued to the district - meaning that there could be duplicate counts if someone holds more than one OFP or IPP in a district.

Proportion of Tier Licensed Teachers at School Districts, Charter Schools, and Other Educational Institutions

While Tier 1 and Tier 2 teachers are licensed teachers, these licenses are issued for a set period of time to fill a particular assignment in a specified district or charter school. As such, PELSB tracks the proportion of Tier 1 licenses held in each district or charter school to provide a better picture of where assignments are unable to be filled by educators with portable/full professional licenses.

The proportion of Tier 1 teachers working at individual school districts, charter schools, and other educational institutions differs substantially. Of the 39 district types with 10 percent or more of their teachers on a Tier 1, all our charter schools. 25 percent or more of all teachers hold a Tier 1 license at four of these schools.

The proportion of Tier 2 teachers is similar, with 94 district types with 10 percent or more of their teachers on a Tier 2 license. Of those, eighty-one are charter schools, five are traditional school districts, and eight other educational institutions.

Table 9 provides data on the proportion of Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 teachers working at each Minnesota school district, charter school, and other educational institution.

Proportion and Distribution of Tier Licensed Teachers among Minnesota Schools, Charter Schools, and Other Educational Institutions

Traditional public school districts employ far more licensed teachers in Minnesota than either charter schools or other educational institutions, with nearly 90 percent of the state's 80,357 licensed teachers with an assignment in 2021-2022 working in a traditional public school district. Meanwhile, charters schools employ eight percent of licensed Minnesota teachers while other educational institutions employ two percent. It is notable that while charter schools represent just over 8% of the overall teachers in MN, they use almost half the Tier 1 licenses

Table 10 also provides the percentage distribution of Tier licensed teachers among public school districts, charter schools, and other educational institutions. Public school districts employ the highest percentage of teachers on all license tiers, but charter schools and other educational institutions do employ a disproportionately high percentage of Tier 1 and Tier 2 teachers in the state.

Table 11 provides a breakdown of the proportion of tier licensed teachers within public school districts, charter schools, and other educational institutions.

Although public school districts employ the largest number of Tier 1 teachers, less than three percent of teachers working in public school districts hold a Tier 1 or Tier 2 license, while nearly fifteen percent of teachers working in a charter school hold a Tier 1 or Tier 2 license. Additionally, traditional public school districts have a much higher percentage of Tier 4 teachers than other district types.

When it comes to where teachers are employed, more than half of all Minnesota teachers worked in the 7-County Twin Cities area.

Additionally, the percent of Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 teachers remained relatively consistent across tiers in relation to overall percentage of teachers in the region.

The data in Table 12 provides a more holistic picture of the teacher shortage, identifying which districts are struggling to hire teachers with a full professional license.
