We, Mrs. Mike Holm, Secretary of State; Leroy E. Matson, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; Frank T. Gallagher, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; Clayton Parks, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District, and Paul J. Jaroscak, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on September 28, 1954, the certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the 1954 Primary Election, and we have prepared therefrom a statement of the whole number of votes cast at said Primary Election for the office of United States Senator in Congress, for the several State Officers, Representatives in Congress, Senators in the Legislature, Representatives in the Legislature, Judges of District Court, and for Treasurer of the Board of Education, School District No. 6, Cass and Itasca Counties, and we have specified the names of the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast, which statement is as follows:
