We, Joseph L. Donovan, Secretary of State; Thomas Gallagher, Associate Judge of the Supreme Court; Martin A. Nelson, Associate Judge of the Supreme Court; William D. Gunn, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, and James C. Otis, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on September 23, 1958, the certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the September 9, 1958, Primary Election, and we prepared therefrom a statement of the whole number of votes cast at said Primary Election for United States Senator in Congress, for the several State Officers and for Representatives in Congress, Senators and Representatives in the State Legislature, and Judges of District Court, and we have specified the names of the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast, which statement is as follows.
