We, Joseph L. Donovan, Secretary of State; Frank T. Gallagher, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; Lee Loevinger, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; Earl J. Lyons, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District; Archie L.
