DEPARTMENT OF STATE:

We, Joseph L. Donovan, Secretary of State; William P. Murphy, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; James C. Otis, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; David E. Marsden, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District; and Douglas K. Amdahl, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on September 27, 1966, the Certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the September 13, 1966 Primary Election for United States Senator in Congress, Representatives in Congress, State Officers, Senators and Representatives in the Legislature, Associate Justices of Supreme Court, and Judges of the District Court for the State of Minnesota and such district returns as the law requires to be made to the State Canvassing Board, and we have specified the names of the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast, which statement follows.
