We, Mike Holm, Secretary of State, Frank T. Gallagher, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Oscar R. Knutson, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Royden S. Dane, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District, and Frank E. Reed, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on November 21, 1950, the certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the November 7, 1950 General Election, and we have prepared therefrom a statement of the whole number of votes cast at said election for and against the Proposed Amendments to the Constitution of the State, for the several State Officers, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, Associate Justices of the Supreme Court, Representatives in Congress, Judges of the District Court, Senators and Representatives in the Legislature from such districts as are required by law to be certified by this Board, Chairman and Treasurer of School District No. 6, Itasca County, and we have specified the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each, which statement is as follows:

**Constitutional Amendments**

First—

Shall the Constitution of the State of Minnesota be amended by adding a new section to section I of article 9 thereof placing a portion of the proceeds of the occupation tax on those engaged in mining iron ore or other ores, equal to the proceeds of an occupation tax of one per cent in the Veterans Compensation Fund?

YES, received .....	594,092
NO, received .....	290,870

And it appearing that a majority of the electors voting at said election have voted Yes, said amendment is hereby declared Adopted.

## Second—

Shall the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, Article IV, Section 32 (b), be repealed, and shall Article VIII, Section 2, be amended so as to provide that 75 per cent of the net proceeds from the use, sale, or other disposition of all lands shall remain perpetual trust funds, providing for the investment of the principal thereof and the disposition of the income therefrom, and further providing that 25 per cent of the net proceeds from the use, sale, or other disposition of all lands shall be paid into a forestry revolving fund, the principal and interest of which shall be used to promote a forestry management and production program and to rehabilitate cut-over timber areas in such manner as the legislature may provide?

And it appearing that a majority of the electors voting at said election have voted No, said amendment is hereby declared Lost.

## Third—

Shall the Constitution, Article IX, Sec. 5, be amended so as to provide that the proceeds of the excise tax on petroleum products be apportioned as follows: Of the proceeds of such tax, one-half thereof in Trunk Highway Fund, 6% thereof for road and street purposes on the basis of population among cities of over 100,000 population, and 44% thereof in the State Road and Bridge Fund.
