PREFACE

The State Canvassing Board for the General Election held in the State of Minnesota on November 6, 1962 met, pursuant to law, on November 20, 1962 at the office of the Secretary of State at 10:00 A.M. At that hour the report of the County Canvassing Board of Hennepin County had not been received. The Board adjourned and met again on November 23, 1962. On that date it signed and filed with the Secretary of State a final report with respect to all offices canvassed by it except that of Governor. The Board met again on November 26, 1962 at 2:00 P.M. and stated in writing the differing views of the Board members concerning the amended returns from ten counties for the office of Governor. It also signed a statement exhibiting the original and amended totals for Governor in the ten counties. On November 29, 1962 the Board met in final session pursuant to an order of the Supreme Court of Minnesota, directing that the Board accept and count the amended returns from the ten counties and declare the result for the office of Governor. On that date in a report signed by all members the Board declared that Karl F. Rolvaag received 619,580 votes; that Elmer L. Andersen received 619,722 votes; and that William Braatz received 7,234 votes; and that Elmer L. Andersen, having received the highest number of votes, is declared elected Governor.

Supplementary reports covering the results of the gubernatorial recount and the proposed recount for Lieutenant Governor will be issued at a later date.

We, Joseph L. Donovan, Secretary of State; Thomas Gallagher, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; Martin A. Nelson, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; Albin S. Pearson, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District; and Luther Sletten, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on November 23, 1962, the certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the November 6, 1962 General Election, and we have prepared therefrom a statement of the whole number of votes cast at said election for and against the Proposed Amendments to the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, for the several State Officers and for Representatives in Congress, Senators and Representatives in the State Legislature, and Judges of District Court, and we have specified the names of the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast which statement is as follows. The candidate in each case whose name appears in capital letters having received the highest number of votes is hereby declared duly elected to that office.

**REPORT OF THE STATE CANVASSING BOARD FOR
THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE STATE OF
MINNESOTA NOVEMBER 6, 1962 WITH RESPECT TO
THE OFFICE OF GOVERNOR**

The undersigned here set forth our respective positions on the essential issues before this Board.

The undersigned, Joseph L. Donovan, Secretary of State, and Thomas F. Gallagher, Associate Justice of Supreme Court, hold the view that all so-called amended returns from the ten counties set forth on another page of this report should be rejected and that on the basis of original returns KARL F. ROLVAAG be declared elected Governor; and that the basic reasons for this position are expressed in the statement of Canvassing Board member Justice Thomas F. Gallagher in Exhibit A attached hereto.

Pearson, Judge of the District Court, are of the view that all of the amended returns as set forth on another page of this report from ten counties should be accepted and counted, and ELMER L. ANDERSEN be declared the elected Governor

I, Luther Sletten, feel that the Canvassing Board can reconvene where there has been an obvious error in returns made by the various precincts, but that the amended returns must show that there has been substantial compliance with the law with regard to correction of error and its recount of votes, and that in my opinion one amended return, and at the most two of the amended returns show that the law has been substantially complied with, with regard to a recount based upon obvious error. These are legal questions that must be decided by the proper court and the Canvassing Board cannot decide questions of law.

STATEMENT BY THOMAS GALLAGHER
MEMBER, STATE CANVASSING BOARD
NOVEMBER 26, 1962

There does not appear to be any statutory authority vested in a county canvassing board under which it may reconvene after it has met, publicly canvassed the election returns evidenced by the summary statements previously filed by the election judges with the county auditor, and made its report to the county auditor therefrom.

Under Minn. St. 204.25 and § 204.26, the election judges must first count the ballots, make a summary statement thereof, place the ballots in sealed envelopes and deliver the sealed envelopes and summary statements to the county auditor. Under § 204.27 and § 204.28 the county auditor is required to insure delivery of such statements and envelopes to his office and if necessary to keep his office open for 24 hours after election for this purpose. Thereafter, under this section, he is required to keep them in his office in a safe place.

Under § 204.29 a county canvassing board is required to meet in the auditor's office within 10 days after the general election to publicly canvass the general election returns as evidenced by the summary statements previously delivered to the auditor by the various election judges. In making such a canvass, they have access to the summary statements but not to the sealed ballots except as governed by § 204.30.

Under § 204.30 in such a canvass the county canvassing board may, upon a four-fifths vote where there is an "obvious error in the counting and recording of the vote," as evidenced by the summary statements, order an inspection of the sealed envelopes in which the ballots have been placed. Such inspection is required to be made on notice to and in the presence of the candidates involved. The specific language of § 204.30 requires that such procedure may be followed by the county canvassing board in "conducting the canvass * * * as provided by law." There is no statutory provision for any canvass other than the original canvass provided for in § 204.29, so it would seem clear that it is only in conducting the original canvass thereunder that the procedure outlined may be followed.

Of course, the construction of these statutes — §§ 204.25-30 inclusive, in last analysis is a judicial function. Accordingly, I feel that I should refrain from executing the certified statement required of the State Canvassing Board under § 204.31 until such time as the Supreme Court shall have determined the issues described. Presumably, it can do this shortly pursuant to the jurisdiction granted to it under § 203.38.
