Legislative Charge

Under Minnesota Statutes, section 126C.15, the basic skills revenue under section [126C.10, subdivision 4](#), must be reserved and used to meet the educational needs of pupils who enroll under-prepared to learn and whose progress toward meeting state or local content or performance standards is below the level that is appropriate for learners of their age. Basic skills revenue may also be used for programs designed to prepare children and their families for entry into school whether the student first enrolls in kindergarten or first grade.

Executive Summary

The tables below show expenditures for Finance Code 317 Basic Skills classified by both program codes and object codes. Please see the Uniform Financial Accounting and reporting Standards (UFARS) Manual for more information and descriptions of these codes ([UFARS \(mn.gov\)](#)).

Introduction

The information in this report has been compiled from FY 2023 Uniform Financial Accounting and Reporting Standards (UFARS) financial data. All Minnesota school districts and charter schools¹ must report their audited financial data for the previous fiscal year to the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) by November 30 and submit an audited financial statement to MDE by December 31 (Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.77, subdivision 3).

This report shows total expenditures reported in UFARS Finance Code 317 Basic Skills.

Prior to fiscal year 2024, any of the following may be provided to meet the learners' needs as stated in Minnesota Statutes, section 126C.15:

- (1) direct instructional services under the assurance of mastery program according to section [124D.66](#);
- (2) remedial instruction in reading, language arts, mathematics, other content areas, or study skills to improve the achievement level of these learners;
- (3) additional teachers and teacher aides to provide more individualized instruction to these learners through individual tutoring, lower instructor-to-learner ratios, or team teaching;
- (4) a longer school day or week during the regular school year or through a summer program that may be offered directly by the site or under a performance-based contract with a community-based organization;
- (5) comprehensive and ongoing staff development consistent with district and site plans according to section [122A.60](#) and to implement plans under section [120B.12](#), subdivision 4a, for teachers, teacher

aides, principals, and other personnel to improve their ability to identify the needs of these learners and provide appropriate remediation, intervention, accommodations, or modifications;

- (6) instructional materials, digital learning, and technology appropriate for meeting the individual needs of these learners;
- (7) programs to reduce truancy, encourage completion of high school, enhance self-concept, provide health services, provide nutrition services, provide a safe and secure learning environment, provide coordination for pupils receiving services from other governmental agencies, provide psychological services to determine the level of social, emotional, cognitive, and intellectual development, and provide counseling services, guidance services, and social work services;
- (8) bilingual programs, bicultural programs, and programs for English learners;
- (9) all-day kindergarten;
- (10) early education programs, parent-training programs, school readiness programs, kindergarten programs for four-year-olds, voluntary home visits under section [124D.13](#), subdivision 4, and other outreach efforts designed to prepare children for kindergarten;
- (11) extended school day and extended school year programs; and
- (12) substantial parent involvement in developing and implementing remedial education or intervention plans for a learner, including learning contracts between the school, the learner, and the parent that establish achievement goals and responsibilities of the learner and the learner's parent or guardian.

For fiscal year 2024 and later, any of the following may be provided to meet the learners' needs as stated in Minnesota Statutes, section 126C.15:

- (1) remedial instruction and necessary materials in reading, language arts, mathematics, other content areas, or study skills to improve the achievement level of these learners;
- (2) additional teachers and teacher aides to provide more individualized instruction to these learners through individual tutoring, lower instructor-to-learner ratios, or team teaching;
- (3) a longer school day or week during the regular school year or through a summer program that may be offered directly by the site or under a performance-based contract with a community-based organization;
- (4) programs to reduce truancy; provide counseling services, guidance services, and social work services; and provide coordination for pupils receiving services from other governmental agencies;
- (5) bilingual programs, bicultural programs, and programs for English learners;
- (6) early education programs, parent-training programs, early childhood special education, school readiness programs, kindergarten programs for four-year-olds, voluntary home visits under section [124D.13, subdivision 4](#), and other outreach efforts designed to prepare children for kindergarten;
- (7) transition programs operated by school districts for special education students until the age of 22;
- (8) substantial parent involvement in developing and implementing remedial education or intervention plans for a learner, including learning contracts between the school, the learner, and the parent that establish achievement goals and responsibilities of the learner and the learner's parent or guardian; and

- (9) professional development for teachers on meeting the needs of English learners, using assessment tools and data to monitor student progress, and reducing the use of exclusionary discipline, and training for tutors and staff in extended day programs to enhance staff's knowledge in content areas.

Analysis

The tables shown below demonstrate expenditures classified by functional area and object codes. The functional area refers to the program codes in UFARS. For more information please see the UFARS Manual, Chapter 3- Program Dimension for more information on each functional area (Program Codes) and Chapter 5- Object Dimension ([UFARS](#)).

See Table 1 for Finance Code 317 Basic Skills expenditures for Elementary and Secondary Regular Instruction program codes. This table includes Fund 01 General Fund and Fund 04 Community Service Fund. Please note Program Code 219 English Learner (EL) is also funded with additional English Learner revenue. Approximately \$59 million of English Learner expenditures is included within basic skills funding. In the future a specific Finance Code will be assigned to English Learners. Program Code 217 Assurance of Mastery will no longer be included in basic skills funding in Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 and later due to 2023 legislative changes.

See Table 2 for Finance Code 317 Basic Skills expenditures for Pupil Support Services program codes. This table includes Fund 01 General Fund and Fund 04 Community Service Fund. In FY 2024, Program Code 720 Health Services was removed as an allowable use of Basic Skills funding.

See Table 3 for Finance Code 317 Basic Skills expenditures by object codes. This table includes Fund 01 General Fund and Fund 04 Community Service Fund. This table illustrates a breakdown of Basic Skills expenditures by salary and benefits, purchased services, supplies or materials and capital expenditures.

See Table 4 for Finance Code 317 Basic Skills expenditures by program codes. This table includes Fund 01 General Fund and Fund 04 Community Service Fund. This table illustrates a breakdown of Basic Skills expenditures by elementary and secondary regular instruction, special education instruction, community education services, instructional support services and pupil support services.

See Table 5 for a summary of Finance Code 317 Basic Skills reported in Fund 04 Community Service. This table illustrates a breakdown of preschool instructional program, early childhood and family education and school readiness program codes. Six school districts and one charter school reported basic skills in fund 04.

Conclusion

Local Education Agencies (LEAs) throughout the state utilize Compensatory Revenue in different priority structures. Depending on other sources and uses of revenues, LEAs may focus specific program or materials being paid for by Compensatory or through other funds. Since LEAs can use Compensatory funding for English Learner costs in addition to the specific English Learner revenue reported through Basic Skills, the information may look skewed. This will be resolved in Fiscal Year 2025 when English Learner Revenue will be separated out and costs will be able to be reported directly against the English Learner revenue, or LEAs may use Compensatory for additional English Learner program costs.
