## Regional Parks Operation and Maintenance Grants

## Introduction

The 1989 Minnesota Legislature appropriated \$2 million for fiscal year (FY) 1990 for Metropolitan Area regional park operations and maintenance grants. The funds, appropriated to the Minnesota Department of Trade and Economic Development, were distributed by the Metropolitan Council to regional park implementing agencies pursuant to Minn. Stat. 473.351. That statute requires the Council to report the amount distributed to each agency and its estimate of the percentage of operations and maintenance expenditures paid for with these grants.

## Grant Disbursements

The figures below show each park agency's 1989 operations and maintenance budget, the FY 1990 state grant to the agency distributed in 1989, and the percentage of the agency's budget covered by the state grant.
