Dear Senators and Representatives,

Pursuant to [Minn. Stat. § 14.116 \(a\) \(2022\)](#), by January 15 each year, each agency must submit its rulemaking docket maintained under section [14.366](#), and the official rulemaking record required under section [14.365](#) for any rule adopted during the preceding calendar year, to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative policy and budget committees with jurisdiction over the subject matter of the proposed rule.

- Commerce adopted the following rules during this preceding calendar year:
 - Minnesota Rules 2022, Chapter 2876, Adopted Rules Relating to Small Corporate Offering Registration Statement, adopted December 27, 2023.
 - The rules are not effective until published in the State Register. The Department anticipates publication occurring in January 2024. The official rulemaking record will not be final until the rules are effective.
