Attached please find the FY 2023 year-end report of expenditures and reimbursements related to the Department of Military Affairs' Emergency Services open appropriation. This report includes expenditures and eligibility for reimbursements from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and eligibility for reimbursements under the State of Minnesota's Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC). Three missions (under Executive Orders 22-23, 23-01 and 23-02) were completed in FY 2023. Also included in this report are two missions (under Executive Orders 22-13 and 22-15) that incurred expenses in both FY 2022 and FY 2023.
