Subject: 2024 Operating Costs Report

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 462A.20, subd. 4, I am submitting the Agency's Operating Costs Report for FY 2023 and Budget Plan for FY 2024.

Our FY 2023 operating budget was \$41.1 million and we estimate our operating budget will be \$49.4 million for FY 2024. This increase is driven both by increased costs associated with existing employees as well as the addition of new employees necessary to implement the historic state housing resources and the doubling of agency programs resulting from the 2023 Legislative session. Total assistance provided in FY 2023 was \$1.846 billion and our ratio of operating expenses to assistance provided was 2.28%.

Also enclosed is the Agency's FY 2023 Financial Report, which includes the audited financial statements for all of the Agency's funds. An independent certified public accounting firm audits the Agency's financial statements every year. The procedures used to audit the Agency's administrative expenses are primarily analytical in nature. For the larger individual amounts included in the salaries and benefits and other general operating expense lines, comparisons are made to the prior year. Large fluctuations, if any, are identified, reviewed and assessed for reasonableness. The FY2023 Financial Report fulfills the statutory requirement that the financial statement include information on expenditures and receipts relating to debt issuance and administration, and loan origination and administration.
