#### **Purpose**

#### Introduction

As required, each replacement service provider as defined by Minnesota Statutes 473.388 has provided to the Council the total operating expenses projected for 2024 and the estimated operating reserve balance as of December 31, 2023. The Metropolitan Council is providing the total operating expenses budgeted in the Council's 2024 Unified Budget, adopted December 13, 2023, and the (unaudited) projected operating reserve fund balance as of December 31, 2023.
