

Expiration of Mandated Reports Report

Department of Employment and Economic Development As required by 2023 Minn. Laws, Chap. 33, Sec. 1 02/26/2024

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As requested by Minnesota Statute 3.197: This report cost approximately \$313.76 to prepare, including staff time, printing, and mailing expenses.

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Overview

As required by 2023 Minn. Laws Chapter 33, Section 1. The Department of Employment and Economic Development has compiled a list of reports mandated by statute that do not include a date for submission of a final report. There are a total of 33 recurring reports mandated of the Department of Employment and Economic Development by Minnesota law. Analysis regarding the usefulness for the continuation of each report is included as well as additional considerations that has been deemed important for legislative awareness.

Recommendation and Analysis

The Department of Employment and Economic Development puts forth one recommendation for altering the requirements for reports: strike the mandate for the Inventory of Economic Development Programs biennial report [2023 Minn. Stat. 116L.35 (a)] The justification for this recommendation is that this report is duplicative with the **Department Program and Services Annual Report**. All information contained in this biennial report, is also contained within the aforementioned annual report. This report is thus burdensome to department staff does not add substantive value to the public or legislators. Striking the requirement to produce this report will thus more efficiently utilize staff time and thus taxpayer resources.
