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Glossary

Assignment: An “assignment” describes an instructional position that requires the teacher to hold a license within a Minnesota public district, charter school, or other educational institution. The following assignments are not included or considered in this report: non-instructional positions, including administrative positions, coaches, or paraprofessionals.

District: For purposes of this report, the term “district” includes public school districts, charter schools, and “other educational institutions” that are required to fill open assignments with licensed teachers.

Duplicated: The total number within a category, even when a single individual may be counted multiple times (i.e., number of licensure fields held by teachers in Minnesota).

Innovative Program Permission: An innovative program permission (IPP) allows a teacher, who holds a Tier 3 or Tier 4 license, to teach in multiple fields within an established innovative program.¹

Legacy Licensure Field: A “legacy licensure field” is a licensure field that is no longer issued. For example, teachers used to be able to obtain a license in “history.” Now, teachers are licensed in “social studies.”

Licensure field: A “licensure field,” “licensure area,” or “subject area” means the content area in which the teacher is authorized and licensed to teach.²

Other Educational Institution: These include intermediate districts and schools, vocational cooperatives, special education cooperatives, state operated schools, regional service cooperatives, miscellaneous cooperatives, and education districts.

Out-of-field permission: An out-of-field permission (OFP) allows a teacher, who holds a Tier 2, Tier 3, or Tier 4 license, to teach in an assignment outside the scope or field of the license held.³

Introduction

As required by Minnesota Rule 8710.0310, subpart 8, this report summarizes the number and percentage of Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 licenses as well as the out-of-field permissions (OFP) and innovative program permissions (IPP) held by teachers actively working in a classroom or holding an unexpired license at the end of the 2022-2023 academic year.

The data tables included in this report are organized by race and ethnicity, licensure field, and district type. Additionally, this report includes several data tables that provide additional teacher licensure data by overall percentages, proportions, and regions. Now that three years have passed since fully transitioning to the tiered licensure system, the data in this report better reflects the changing landscape of Minnesota's teaching profession.

Data Sources

The data in these tables comes from several different sources, including the legacy teacher licensure system, the new teacher licensure database, and the Staff Automated Reporting (STAR) system. These systems capture data at different times and of different populations, meaning that many totals are not consistent across data tables. Context and notes are provided for each data table in their respective sections.

Additionally, race/ethnicity data continues to be drawn from two data sources, one reported by the district (STAR) and the other by the teacher (Educators Online). While PELSB staff is more confident in the accuracy of the race/ethnicity data in this report, improved data collection tools are needed to ensure policy decisions are made using the best information available.

Finally, the information reported from districts (STAR) represents a snapshot in time for that district. Information reported through licensure applications (Educators Online) can reflect a changing landscape over an academic year as an individual may switch tiers mid-year. This may cause some minor inconsistencies within the data presented.

Background

Tiered Licensure

In Minnesota, a teacher providing instruction in a public school, charter school, or other educational institution must hold a license aligned to the field and grade level taught. ([Minn. Stat. 120A.22, subdivision 10.](#))

Tiered Licensure

Following extensive legislative changes in 2017, a new tiered licensure system went into effect on July 1, 2018, which created four different tiered licenses for teachers. Legacy license types were extended an additional year, resulting in full transition to tiered licensure beginning on July 1, 2019.

Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board

The Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board is responsible for issuing licenses and for collecting and reporting data on the number of licensed teachers in Minnesota as well as their assignments. (Minn. Stat. 122A.09, subd. 4; Minn. Stat. 122A.091.)

Notable Findings from the 2022-23 School Year

Tiered Licensure

- As of the 2022-23 school year, there were a little over 114,000 licensed in Minnesota.
- The 2022-23 school year saw the highest used of out-of-filed permissions since the implementation of tiered licensure.

Race and Ethnicity

- Across all racial/ethnic groups, the percentage of teachers who hold a professional license (Tier 3 or Tier 4) is higher than the percentage teachers who hold a Tier 1 or Tier 2 license.
- Teachers of color continue to be more represented among Tier 1 and Tier 2 educators, identifying the need for greater access to professional development and pathways to licensure, such as teacher preparation or the licensure via portfolio.
- 6.16% percent of licensed teachers are teachers of color and/or Indigenous teachers.

Licensure Fields

- Many of Minnesota's teachers are licensed in multiple fields (such as Physics and Chemistry).
- Licensure fields in World Languages and Cultures and Career and Technical Education remain the highest percentage of Tier 1 and Tier 2 licenses.
- Of the total number of Tier 1 licenses, Tier 2 licenses, and OFPs issued, the largest proportion tended to fall into special education fields (over one-fifth of all Tier 1 licenses).

Employment

- Charter schools disproportionately rely on teachers who hold a Tier 1 license compared to public school districts and other educational institutions.
- More than half of all Minnesota teachers filling an assignment requiring a license worked in the 7-County Twin Cities area.
- The percent of Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 teachers remained relatively consistent across tiers in relation to overall percentage of teachers in the region.

Tiered Licensure and Permissions

There were just over 114,000 teachers licensed in Minnesota at the end of the 2022-23 school year, of which a little over 83,000 held assignments in a public school district, charter school, or other educational institution. The 2022-23 school year saw the highest used of out-of-field permissions since the implementation of tiered licensure. One thing to note is that not all OFPs represent a 1.0 FTE position. Therefore, a teacher may only be utilizing an out-of-field permission for a single class a day.

Table 1: Tiered Licensure and Permissions (SYs 2020-21, 2021-22, and 2022-23)

The data in Table 1 represent all teachers in Minnesota that held a license or permission over the last three school years – regardless as to whether they were working in a teaching assignment in a Minnesota public school district.

Race and Ethnicity of Licensed Teachers

The data provided in this section highlights how the race and ethnicity of teachers varies by tiered license type and permission type. Table 3 provides data on the race and ethnicity of teachers who held tiered licenses, OFPs, and IPPs during the 2022-2023 school year. This data is a snapshot, meaning it reflects licenses held as of spring 2022. Table 4 provides the same data as a percentage of the total within each license or permission category. Table 5 provides the same data as a percentage of the total within each race/ethnicity category.

Highlights of the following tables still help identify important information and trends around tiered licensure:

- Across all racial/ethnic groups, the percentage of teachers who hold a professional license (Tier 3 or Tier 4) is higher than the percentage teachers who hold a Tier 1 or Tier 2 license.
- Teachers of color continue to be more represented among Tier 1 and Tier 2 educators, identifying the need for greater access to professional development and pathways to licensure, such as teacher preparation or the licensure via portfolio.
- 6.16% percent of licensed teachers are teachers of color and/or Indigenous teachers.

Licensure Fields

A “licensure field” describes the content area that a teacher is authorized to teach. Each license and permission identifies an applicable licensure field, such as Elementary Education or Chemistry. Because an individual teacher can hold a license with multiple licensure fields, such as a Tier 4 license in Health and Physical Education, the following data includes “duplicate counts” of teachers. Additionally, licensure field categories have changed frequently over the last twenty years - meaning that many licensure areas listed below are a combination of multiple license types (see [Appendix A1](#) for definitions of each licensure field identified here).

Table 7 below provides total numbers of licenses and permissions in each licensure field. The data in this table contains total numbers of licenses - meaning there are duplicate counts of individuals if they hold licenses in more than one field. The proportion of individuals on a tier within a licensure field differs substantially - ranging from 100 percent in some of the World Languages & Culture licensure fields being Tier 1 to the majority of licensure fields having fewer than three percent of Tier 1 licenses. Licensure fields in World Languages and Cultures and Career and Technical Education remain the highest percentage of Tier 1 and Tier 2 licenses. Notably, there are no, or very few, licensure programs in Minnesota aligned to each of these licensure fields.

Tier 1 Licenses, Tier 2 Licenses, and Out-of-Field Permissions Issued, by Licensure Field

Similar to Table 7, the data in Table 8 takes total numbers within Tier 1, Tier 2, and OFPs and considers them as a proportion of the total licenses issued within that license or permission (the column totals 100%, whereas Table 7 the row totals 100%). Of the total number of Tier 1 licenses, Tier 2 licenses, and OFPs issued, the largest proportion tended to fall into special education fields (over one-fifth of all Tier 1 licenses), and an increasingly high percentage of Tier 2 licenses in Elementary Education (nearly one in five Tier 2 licenses). The highest proportion of teachers of teachers, by tier, are as follows:

Employment of Licensed Teachers

Tracking where Minnesota teachers work can be a nuanced process as only Tier 1 licenses, Tier 2 licenses, out-of-field permissions (OFPs), and Innovative Program Permissions (IPPs) are attached to specific school districts. Meanwhile, teachers who hold a Tier 3 or Tier 4 license do not have licenses tied to a particular district. Rather, the Tier 3 and Tier 4 licenses are mobile, meaning that teachers can use their licenses to teach at any public school in Minnesota.

PELSB tracks where licensed teachers work using the Staff Automated Reporting (STAR) system. STAR data reflects a snapshot of employment at the time of the data collection and does not represent changes in position or hiring before or after the district report.

Again, Tier 1 licenses, Tier 2 licenses, out-of-field permissions, and Innovative Program Permissions (IPPs) are tied to a particular teacher, assignment, and employing district. As such, PELSB tracks the number and proportion of Tier 1 and Tier 2 licenses and permissions held in each district or charter school to provide a better picture of where assignments are unable to be filled by educators with full professional licenses (Tier 3 and Tier 4 licenses).

2022-23 School Year Findings

Table 9 provides data on the number of teachers employed in an instructional assignment by district, charter school, and educational institution, by tier license, during the 2022-23 school year. The table also provides data on the number of OFPs and IPPs issued to each district, charter school, and educational institution throughout the course of the school year.

During the 2022-2023 school year, Minnesota public school districts, charter schools, and other educational institutions employed 83,738 teachers throughout the state.⁴ Of those teachers, about 95 percent held a Tier 3 or Tier 4 license.

The number of licensed teachers school districts employed ranged from several larger districts employing more than 1,000 teachers to several charter schools and educational cooperatives employing ten or fewer teachers.

The public school districts employing the largest number of licensed teachers included:

1. Minneapolis Public School District (3,738)
2. St. Paul Public School District (3,738)
3. Anoka-Hennepin Public School District (3,633)
4. Rosemount-Apple Valley-Eagan (2,614)
5. Osseo Public School District (1,763)

The charter schools employing the largest number of licensed teachers included:

1. Minnesota Transitions Charter School (339)
2. Hmong College Prep Academy (242)
3. Community School of Excellence (160)
4. Eagle Ridge Academy Charter School (152)
5. Lakes International Language Academy (150)

The districts employing the largest number of Tier 3 and Tier 4 teachers were the same districts hiring the largest number of total teachers. The largest employers of Tier 1 and Tier 2 teachers also tended to be larger public school districts. However, when looking at proportions, charter schools tend to have a greater proportion of teachers who hold a Tier 1 or Tier 2 license. While Table 8 identifies headcounts, Table 9 provides this data as a proportion of teachers within the district.

During the 2022-23 school year, there were 219 districts – or 39.3% of all districts - that did not fill an instructional assignment with a teacher holding a Tier 1 license.

Table 9: Number of Licensed Teachers and Permission Holders, by District Type

The tiered license data in this table is compiled from the 2022 STAR data collection period that happened during the fall of 2022. Any teacher a district or school hired after the STAR data collection period would not be included in this table. The OFP and IPP data comes from records kept by PELSB's licensing division and was current as of spring 2023.

The data table for the Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 licenses contains headcount - meaning that individuals are counted only once in each district or school. The OFP and IPP data is of the total number of OFPs or IPPS issued to the district - meaning that there could be duplicate counts if someone holds more than one OFP or IPP in a district.

Proportion and Distribution of Licensed Teachers among Minnesota Schools, Charter Schools, and Other Educational Institutions

Table 11 provides the percentage distribution of licensed teachers among public school districts, charter schools, and other educational institutions. Public school districts employ the highest percentage of teachers on all license tiers, but charter schools and other educational institutions do employ a disproportionately high percentage of Tier 1 and Tier 2 teachers in the state.

Public school districts employ far more licensed teachers in Minnesota than either charter schools or other educational institutions, with over 80% of the state's 83,738 licensed teachers with an assignment during the 2021-2022 school year. Meanwhile, charter schools employ 8.5% of the state's Minnesota teachers and other educational institutions employ over 8% percent of the state's licensed teachers. It is notable that while charter schools represent 8.5% of the overall teachers in MN, charter schools employ almost 40% the teachers who hold a Tier 1 license.

Economic Development Regions

The tables in this section highlight similarities and differences among the state's economic development regions.

Key findings include:

- More than half of all Minnesota teachers filling an assignment requiring a license worked in the 7-County Twin Cities area.
- The percent of Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 teachers remained relatively consistent across tiers in relation to overall percentage of teachers in the region.
