Minnesota Statute 18K.04; Subdivision 4 defines hemp licensing data provided by licensees and applicants as private or nonpublic if it contains (1) nondesignated addresses and (2) information identifying specific locations for growing or processing. This subdivision allows the commissioner to disclose private or nonpublic data if it is determined that there is a substantive threat to human health or safety, the environment, or aid in the law enforcement process. Data that is not considered private or nonpublic will be referred to as public data in this report.

Minnesota Statute 18K.04; Subdivision 5 requires the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) to:

- Establish written procedures to ensure that Hemp Licensing Data is only accessed by individuals authorized to do so by law.
- Create a data audit trail for all queries and responses, including the specific purpose for which data is requested and, if applicable, disclosed, and all actions in which data are entered, updated, accessed, shared, or disseminated.
- Submit a hardcopy of the data audit trail by January 15 of each odd-numbered year, to the commissioner of administration; the chairs and ranking members of the legislative committees and divisions with jurisdiction over agriculture policy and finance, public safety, and data practices; and the Legislative Commission on Data Practices and Personal Data Privacy or its successor commission.

This legislative report fulfills MDA's requirement for submission of the data audit trail under Chapter 18K and verifies that the agency has established the following departmental written policies and procedures for access and handling of public and non-public data by authorized employees and a written procedure for public data requests.
