

Collector class

Minnesota statute 168.10

Please note: Any vehicle registered in this class must be owned and operated solely as a collector's item and not for general transportation purposes. At the time of application, the owners must certify that they have one or more vehicles registered in their name with regular Minnesota license plates and the registration must be current. Collector class vehicles may display a single plate on the back only if the vehicle is a 1972 model year or older. All other vehicles must display plates on both front and back. Plates with asterisks (*) cannot be ordered online.

Plate fees: Standard double plate: \$15.50 for initial and replacement plates. Single plate or motorcycle: \$13.50 for initial and replacement plates.
