

## Major State Aids and Taxes: An Overview of the 2021 Update

The following provides a brief overview of the longer publication <u>Major State Aids and Taxes: A Comparative Analysis, 2021 Update</u>, which highlights major aids provided to the local governments and people in Minnesota and lists the major taxes collected. The per capita amounts were calculated using 2021 population.
