

# A DECADE'S WORTH OF CHANGE: MINNESOTA CITIES, 2010 TO 2020

This document contains data on the demographic composition of Minnesota's cities, highlighting changes that occurred between Census 2010 and Census 2020. As of 2020, more than 4.7 million Minnesotans lived in a city – approximately 83% of the entire state population. Since 2010, the number of people living in Minnesota cities has grown by 409,846 (an increase of 9.4%). Nearly all growth occurred in cities with a population of at least 25,000.

The number of Minnesota city dwellers who identify as White declined by 17,075 (-0.5%). All other racial groups increased. The largest numeric gains occurred for Black or African American (+122,975; +46.2%), Two or More Races (+114,064; +122.6%), Hispanic (+90,494; +38.2%) and Asian (+84,163; +40.5%).

The largest overall population growth occurred in cities with a population between 50,000 and 99,999. Since 2010, cities of that size grew by 307,954 residents (+35.6%).

The largest overall population declines occurred in cities with a population between 10,000 to 24,999. Cities of that size declined in population by 42,192 (-4.3%).
