
2024 Interagency Agreements and Transfers Report

Minnesota Statutes, Section 15.0395

Introduction

This report outlines Minnesota Department of Natural Resources' (DNR's) agreements with other agencies with a cumulative value of more than \$100,000, and each of the transfers of more than \$100,000 within the DNR or between the DNR and another agency that occurred during Fiscal Year 2024.

The report contains two sections: 1) interagency agreements and service-level agreements, and 2) transfers. These sections include the total amount of each agreement or transfer, a description of each agreement or transfer, and the legal authority for each agreement or transfer.

Minnesota Statutes, section 15.0395 Interagency Agreements and Intra-Agency Transfers

(a) By October 15, 2018, and annually thereafter, the head of each agency must provide reports to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over the department or agency's budget on:

(1) each interagency agreement or service-level agreement, including any renewal or extension of an existing interagency or service-level agreement with another agency if the cumulative value of those agreements between two agencies is more than \$100,000 in the previous fiscal year; and

(2) transfers of appropriations between accounts within or between agencies, if the cumulative value of the transfers is more than \$100,000 in the previous fiscal year.

The report must include the statutory citation authorizing the agreement, transfer or dollar amount, purpose, the effective date of the agreement, and the duration of the agreement. Interagency agreements and service-level agreements that authorize enterprise central services and transfers specifically required by statute or session law are not required to be reported under this section.

(b) As used in this section, "agency" includes the departments of the state listed in section 15.01, a multimember state agency in the executive branch described in section 15.012, paragraph (a), the Department of Information Technology Services [now Minnesota IT Services] and the Office of Higher Education.

Preparing this report cost approximately \$869, which consisted of 11 staff hours.
