Dear Governor Walz, Senators, Representatives, Mr. Steller, Director Yurich and Revisor Inman:


The Board of Barber Examiners has conducted a review of its Administrative Rules in Minnesota Chapter 2100 and finds the following obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative rules:

1. Minnesota Rule 2100.4500 Instructor Registration Qualifications is duplicative of Minnesota Statute Section 154.056(3).

2. Minnesota Rule 2100.2500 Examination dates states that examinations are held in the second week of February, May, August, and November. Examinations are currently held in the first week of these months. Statute

The Minnesota Board of Barber Examiners developed a bill in 2024 to repeal these rules and submitted it to the appropriate policy committees in the Senate and House. The board intends to submit a similar bill in 2025.
